Provincial election candidates hit campaign trail

Let the campaigning begin — again.

Ontario's provincial election campaign officially started Monday after the Liberal government dissolved the legislature.

That means residents will soon be seeing plenty of election signs popping up across town and the door-to-door delivery of candidates' campaign literature — all in the lead up to voting day Wednesday, Oct. 10.

This is the third time in less than two years some Milton voters have been asked to go to the polls. There was a federal election in January 2006, a municipal election last November, followed by a municipal byelection in June of this year.

Milton voters make up a large part of the Halton riding, which also includes areas of north Burlington and north Oakville totalling more than 103,000 eligible voters.

To help residents navigate the election landscape, here is a list of the candidates running in the riding.

Incumbent Ted Chudleigh is the Conservative candidate. His Milton campaign office is located at the Derry Plaza on the northeast corner of Ontario Street and Derry Road, beside Ned Devine's Irish Alehouse and Pub (905-864-8196); website: www.tedchudleigh.com.

Businessperson Gary Zemlak is carrying the Liberal banner for the Halton riding. His campaign office is at 1400
