While Milton's blueline remains rather inexperienced, Novak said returnees Jamie Hawkrigg, David Fortino and Jeremy Price are all ready to step things up.

"We need someone to take the bull by the horns back there, which we're hoping Jamie or David can do."

Like Vallorani, Vince Cusick — who prevented more than a few lopsided affairs through the latter half of 2006/07 — recently turned down an OHL offer (opting to go the school route) and will be back between the pipes.

Along with what he considers to be a significant improvement in terms of sheer talent — skat-

ing in particular — Novak stressed that the IceHawks' conditioning will be a whole lot better this season as well.

In addition to having at least one extra practice a week, Milton will be part of the Beyond the Next Level off-ice conditioning program in Oakville on the Sundays they don't play.

Better conditioning and a strong work ethic could be especially crucial through the early stages of the season, with the West being in a state of transition and — arguably — more games genuinely up for grabs right now.
