

Go on tour — right here in Milton

Residents are being encouraged to discover local tourist destinations through the Milton Chamber of Commerce's Escarpment Country Adventure promotion.

The initiative, which runs until October, offers a variety of self-guided tours that include conservation areas, farm markets, museums, artisans, golf courses, horse racing and restaurants.

The tours can be downloaded at www.escarpment-countryadventure.ca. Those who visit the website can also enter for a chance to win an overnight stay in one of Escarpment Country's hotels, bed and breakfasts or campgrounds.

"The Escarpment Country Adventure will bring more visitors to Milton, but more importantly it will help our own residents discover the wide variety of recreation and leisure destinations that are available right in their own backyards," said

The following is a list of the tours available:

- **Sure Bet Tour** — includes a round of golf at the Crosswinds Golf and Country Club, a browse through the unique artisan works at Galactic Art Glass Studio, walk around Milton's historic downtown and a trip to the Mohawk Racetrack

- **A Day in the Country Tour** — offers hiking and biking through the forests of Hilton Falls, a stop off at Chudleigh's to pick apples and sample sweet treats from the bakery and a paddleboat ride at Kelso Conservation Area

- **Farm Fresh Tour** — provides an opportunity to meet and learn about the wildlife at

Mountsberg Conservation Area, a visit to Springridge Farm to pick fruit and browse through the gift barn and a walk around the pristine waters of Crawford Lake

- **Heritage Tour** — offers a glimpse of history with antique tractors, farm equipment, heritage buildings and rural artifacts at Country Heritage Park and a visit to the Halton Region Museum to see historical exhibits and artifacts

- **Outdoor Adventure Tour** — includes rock climbing at Rattlesnake Point Conservation Area, a stroll on the boardwalk around Crawford Lake with a visit to the reconstructed 15th-century Iroquoian Village and hiking at Mount Nemo Conservation Area.
