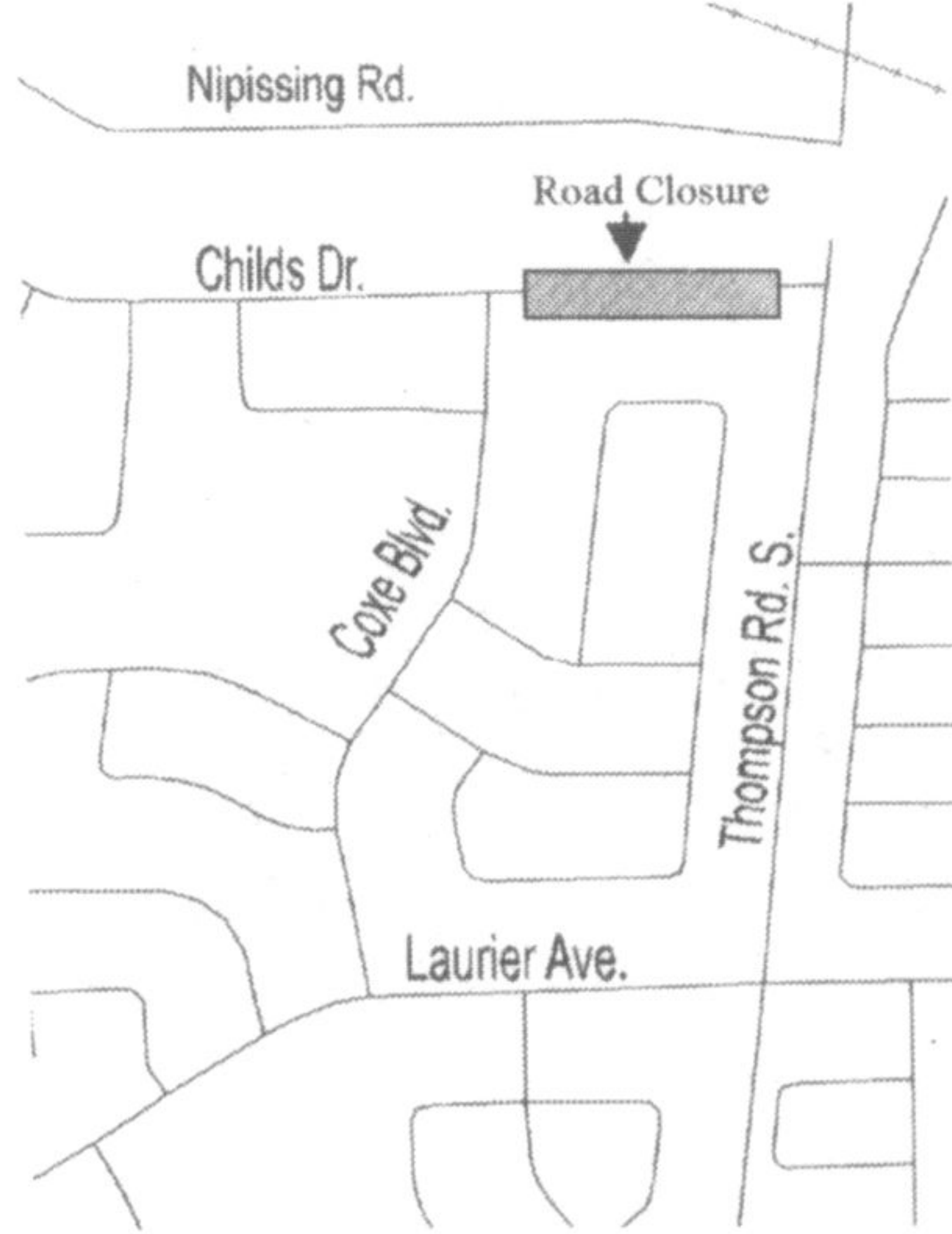

Notice of Temporary Road Closures

Childs Drive at Thompson Road South

As part of The Town of Milton's continuing roads infrastructure improvement program, Engineering Services will implement a temporary road closure of Childs Drive between Thompson Road South and Coxe Blvd. Access to all properties between Thompson Road and Coxe Blvd. will be from Coxe Blvd. or Ontario St. only. The closure is required to facilitate the installation of a major storm sewer being constructed along the west side of Thompson Road. Closures will be implemented as noted below.

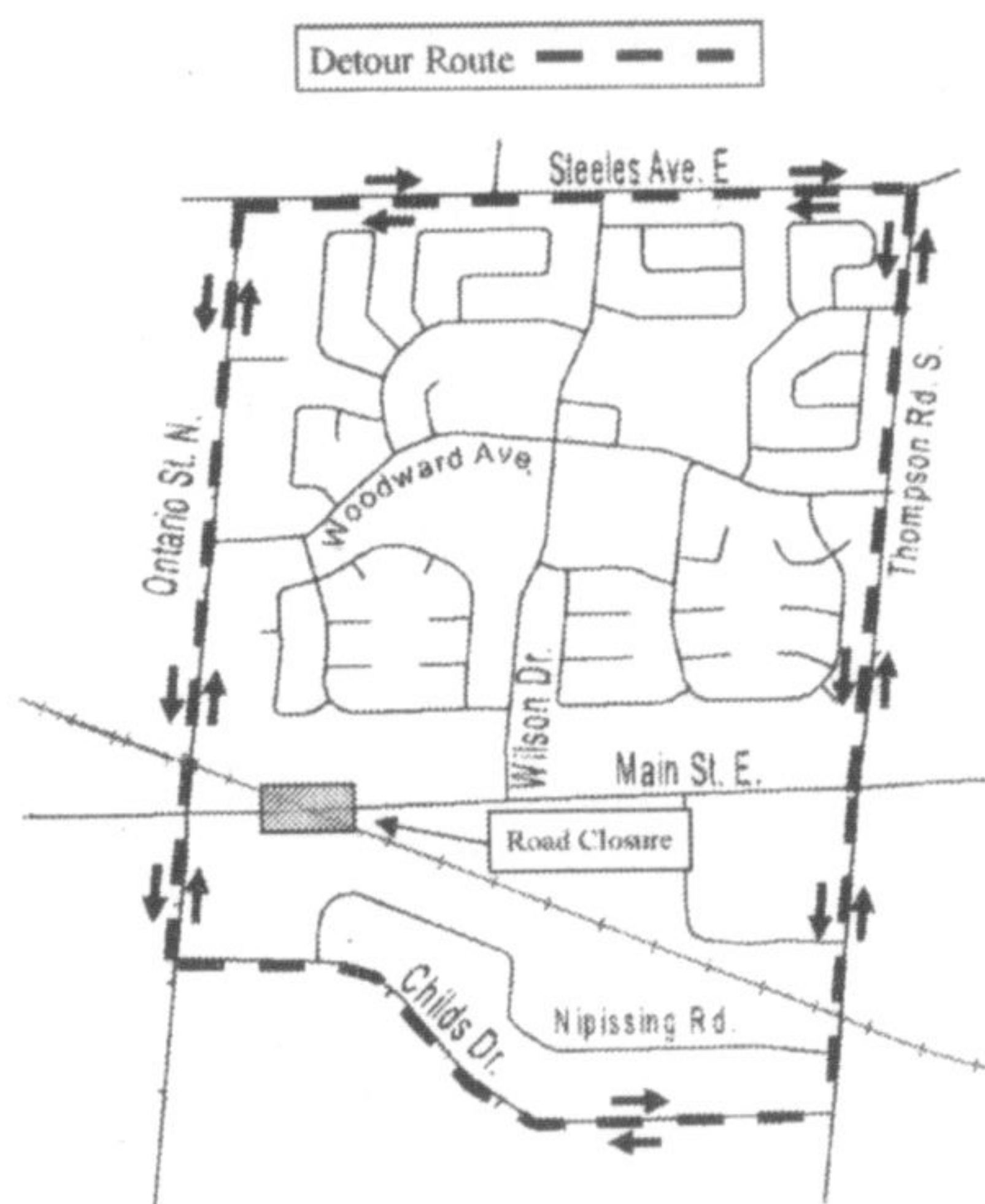
Notice of Temporary Road Closures

**Police searching for thief
 of \$10,000 diamond ring**

*Suspect caught on tape
 during evening robbery*

Police believe a suspect in the brazen, take-it-and-run theft of a diamond ring in Georgetown might be from a neighbouring community like Milton.

A man walked into a Peoples Jewellers store on Guelph Street in Georgetown shortly before 8 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 20, police said, and asked the store clerk to show him engagement rings.

The man expressed interest in a one-karat, 18-karat white gold, princess-cut diamond ring valued at \$10,000.

Police said that when the clerk showed the man the ring, he took it and bolted from the store. A suspect was captured on the store's security video.

"We have yet to identify the suspect. We're hoping someone in Milton may recognize him," said Det. Const. Murray Drinkwater.

He's asking anyone who can assist police in identifying the man to contact investigators.

He explained that people who commit high-end thefts often do it in other communities where they're not known.

The suspect captured on video in this incident is described as white, five-foot-seven, 160 pounds, with a slim build, brown eyes, a scruffy appearance with facial acne scars, crooked front



teeth and tobacco-stained fingers.

At the time of the theft he was wearing a grey baggy sweatshirt, faded blue jeans and a grey knit tuque.
