

Trailer, load swiped from business

A flatbed trailer loaded with lumber — valued at a total of \$50,000 — was stolen Saturday.

Police said an unknown suspect drove through Taiga Forest Products on Harrop Drive with a tractor, hooked up the loaded trailer and drove off sometime just after midnight.

The lumber is valued at \$30,000, while the MacKinnon trailer is valued at about \$20,000.

Trailer and lettuce stolen

A trailer loaded with lettuce was stolen from Truck Town Terminals on Steeles Avenue overnight Saturday.

The 53-foot, 2006 Waba reefer trailer has a reefer unit and is white. It has the licence plate C3596F.

The load and trailer are valued at \$45,000.

Vehicles stolen

Police are investigating two incidents of vehicle theft that occurred within three days of each other.

Unknown suspects stole a minivan from a Cavell Street driveway overnight Tuesday.

Police said the 2005 blue Dodge Caravan is valued at \$10,000 and has the licence plate BCB754.

And overnight Saturday, a black 2000 Chrysler Neon was stolen by unknown suspects from a visitors' parking spot at an Ontario Street town-house complex.

It's valued at \$4,000 and has the licence plate AFLM596.

Man charged in break-in

An arrest has been made in connec-

and 10:15 a.m. Wednesday an unknown suspect entered a vehicle in the parking lot and stole property including a Sirius satellite radio, power tools and accessories and a camera.

The stolen items are valued at \$5,000.

Graffiti investigated

Police are investigating a couple of graffiti incidents.

Police said black and blue paint was recently discovered spray-painted on the back of the concession stand at Lions Sports Park on Thompson Road.

Graffiti was also discovered on the rear of Mac's Milk on Bronte Road South.

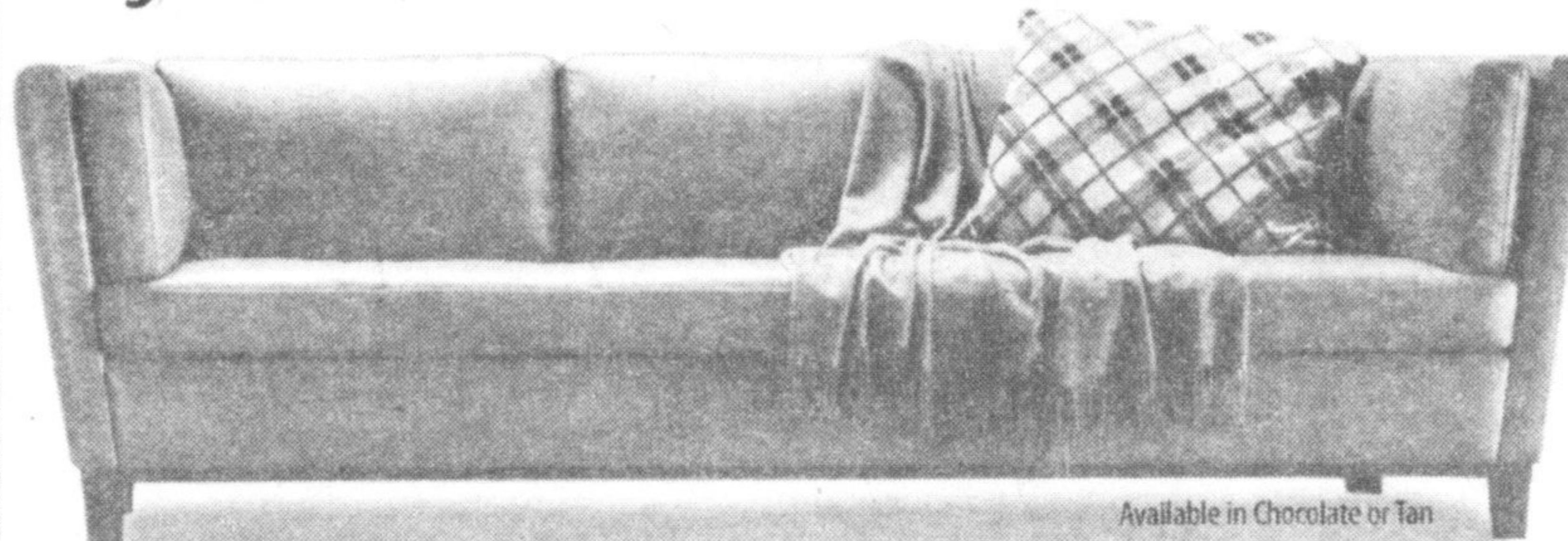
