# Oakville tourney holds number of highlights for atom selects

Milton's atom selects may have had a short-lived run at the recent Frank Sabatino Memorial Tournament in Oakville, but it certainly wasn't short on highlights.

The most notable came in the form of winger Daniel Gaetan claiming the Frank Sabatino Memorial Sportsmanship Award — an honour bestowed on just one player each year.

"Daniel is the most unselfish player I've ever coached," noted coach Robert Atkinson. "It was so great that he won it."

That wouldn't be the only win for the local selects last weekend.

Along with taking two of its three round-robin games — which left them heartbreakingly short of a semifinal berth — Nathan Brady finished first in the defence agility race of the skills competition.

He'd also have a hand in Milton's second-place performance in the relay race, with Gaetan, William Hamilton and Justin Sandluck rounding

out the foursome.

The Winterhawks began and ended the round robin in victory — turning back the Clarkson Hurricanes 3-1 and host Oakville Wolfpack 4-1 — but were denied a spot in the final four by virtue of a tiebreaker.

Sandwiched between these wins was a 5-3 defeat at the hands of the Ottawa-area Kanata Rampage.

Jacob Rondeau stood tall between the pipes throughout the weekend, while Michael Bethune led the overall attack with four goals.

Hamilton scored three times and added an assist, while Colin Sadler collected four helpers. Gaetan (1g, 2a), Sandluck (1g, 1a) and Brady (2a) also fueled Milton's offence.

The atom selects hope to build on last weekend's efforts next month at the London Tournament, where they reigned supreme last year.

stressed that building a strong goalie means developing them — not changing them.

"At the end of the day it's all about stopping the puck, and there's really no right or wrong way to do that. Every goalie's got their own style and you can't try to change that. You've got to work with their strengths.

"Sometimes that can be a balancing act between teaching the techniques and at the same time not changing a goalie too much, but by now it's pretty much second nature."

Agreed Winterhawks midget netminder

Brandon Grant, "Dave hasn't tried to change my style. He's always constructive and positive and he knows when to push me and when to work on repetition so that I don't have to think about what I'm doing in a game situation."

The importance of that last part, Dolecki said, can't be overemphasized.

"There's just no time to think in a game. You've got to instinctively know what to do, and that only comes through repetition. If you're thinking out there, you're in trouble."

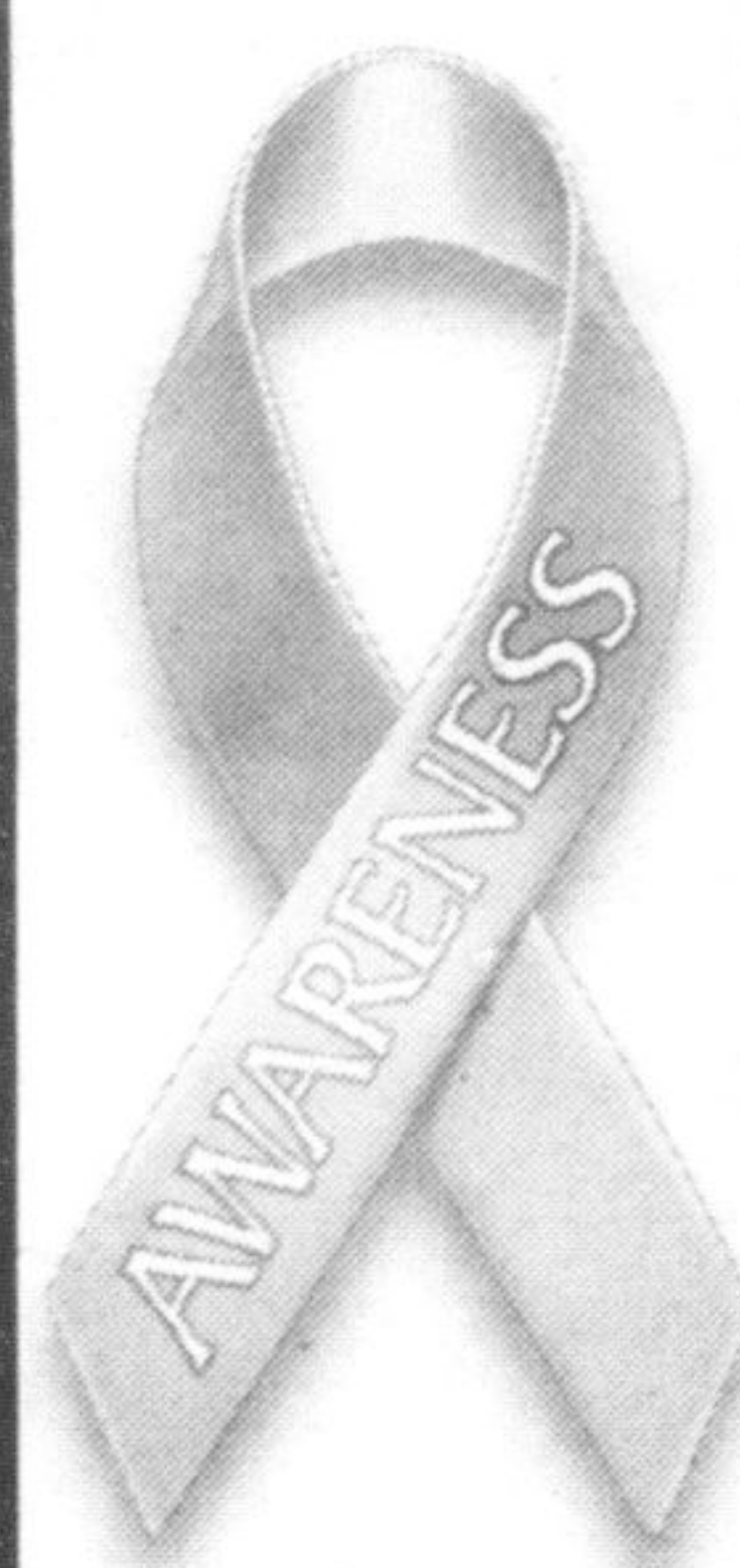
