Sexual, physical abuse alleged at deaf school

Lawyer says he plans to launch lawsuit against provincial government

A lawyer says he plans to launch a class action lawsuit on behalf of former students of E.C. Drury School for the Deaf who allege they were abused.

Saskatchewan-based lawyer Tony Merchant told the Champion he has been contacted by former students of Milton's school for the deaf who allege they were physically and sexually abused.

He said he expects to file a class action lawsuit against the Ontario government within a couple of months.

Merchant wouldn't say how many students have come forward or when




She added if a lawsuit is filed in Ontario, "Any allegations will be taken very seriously and investigated."




