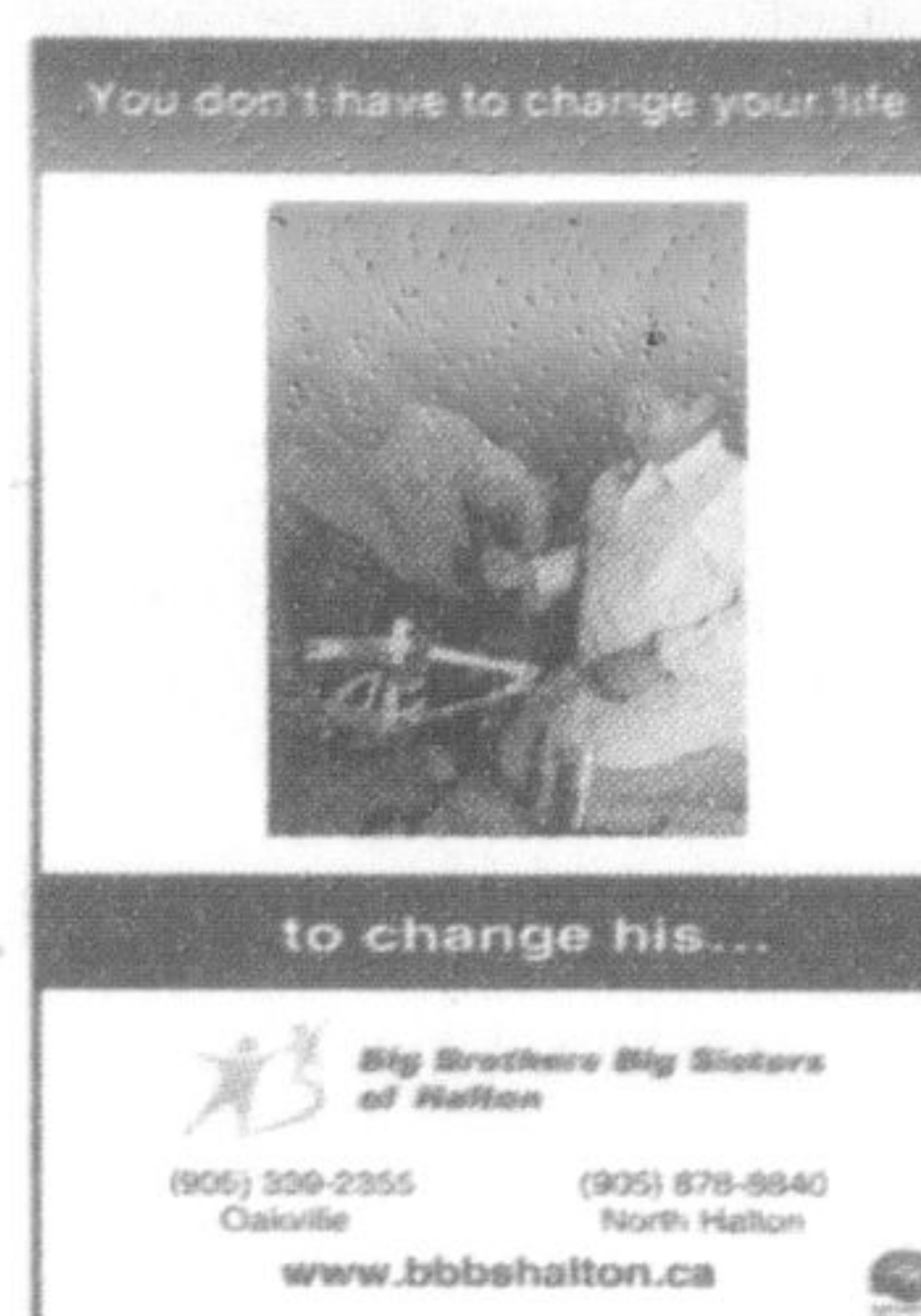
Big need for Big Brothers

A local agency is looking for a few good men — well, actually more than that.

Hoping to find 100 male matches this year, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Halton reminds potential Big Brothers that as little as a couple of hours a week can make a huge difference in the life of a local youth.

Being a Big Brother can be as simple as kicking a ball around, flying a kite or talking about the latest hockey game.

In Milton, the agency has partnered with local businessman Mark Burger of Spokes 'n Slopes — who recently signed up to be an in-school mentor — to create a campaign poster targeting male volunteers.

"You don't have to change your life to change his is the essence of our campaign," said north Halton co-ordinator of volunteers Wendy Somerville. "We want to get across the message to men that being a Big Brother is really about just being a pal to a boy."

Big Brothers are in particular demand in Halton, where about 70 boys are waiting to be matched.

Added Somerville, "Big Brothers are regular people. Role models come in all

shapes and sizes. They are bus drivers, teachers and grandfathers. I think ultimately you just have to want to make a positive impact on the life of a child."

this column, I like to think that I'm a little better equipped to judge their relative merits than I was a year ago.

Some were terrific. Some were dreadful. 'Definitely, Maybe' was... okay. I actually like Ryan Reynolds when he isn't doing trash frat house comedies. He reminds me a little of a young Robert Redford.

And the romantic lead with a charming comic twist is the perfect type of role for him, even if it does

come off a bit like Ryan Reynolds Vehicle #7.

Unfortunately, 'Definitely, Maybe' is one of those movies that looks like it was cobbled together by a bunch of producers who told the writer, "That's great! Now if you could just write in a part for that little girl from 'No Reservations.'" Without the kid, it would have been merely formulaic. With her, it was gimmicky.

I give it two-and-a-half stars out of five.
