## We're tops in Canada



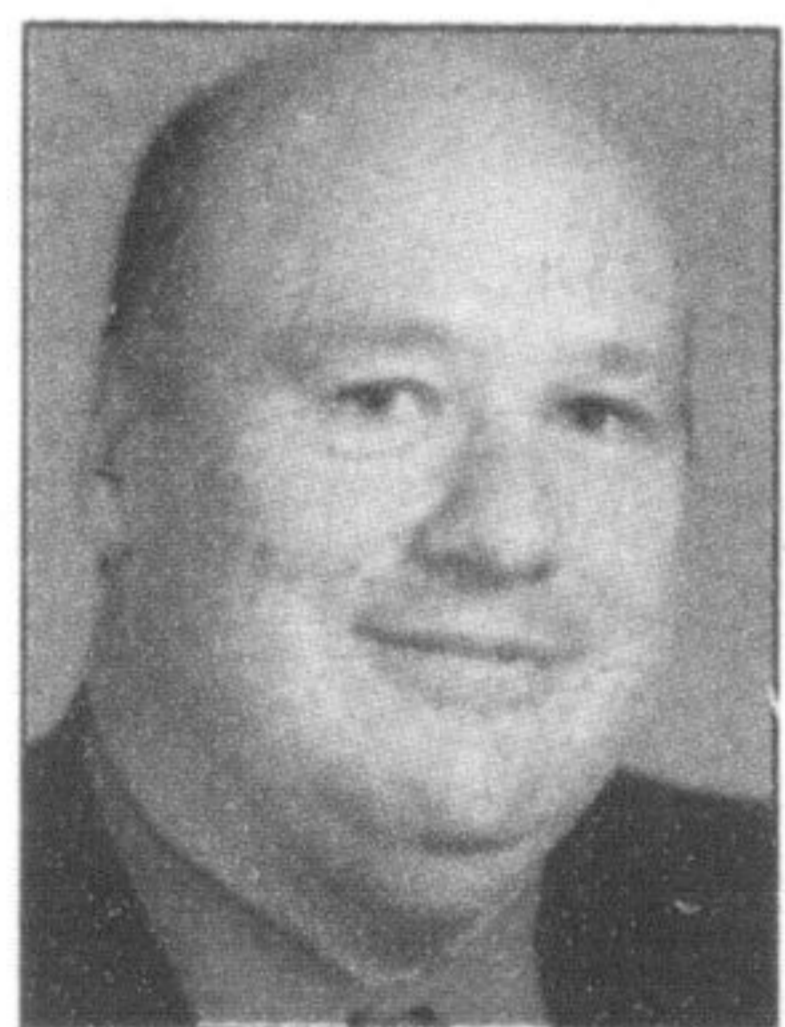

## Champion wins national newspaper award

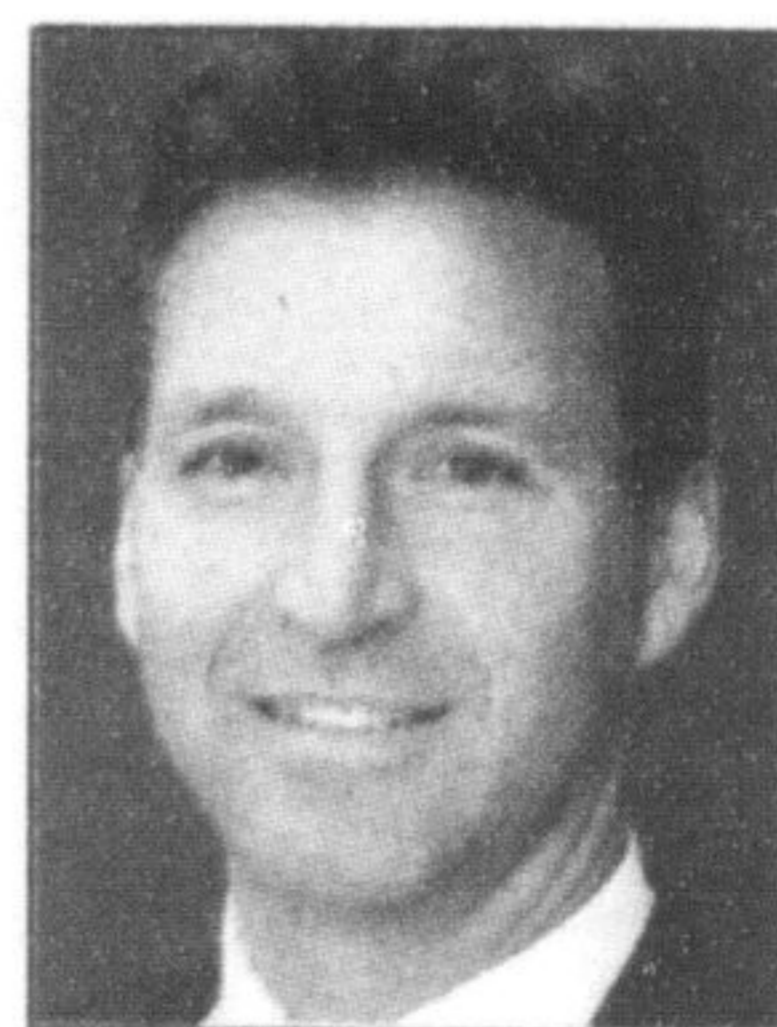
The *Champion* truly lived up to its name this week, taking top honours in a nation-wide newspaper competition.

Your hometown paper took first place in the category of Best All Round Newspaper in its circulation class — 12,500 to 24,999 — in the Canadian Community Newspapers Association's (CCNA) 2008 Better Newspapers Competition.
