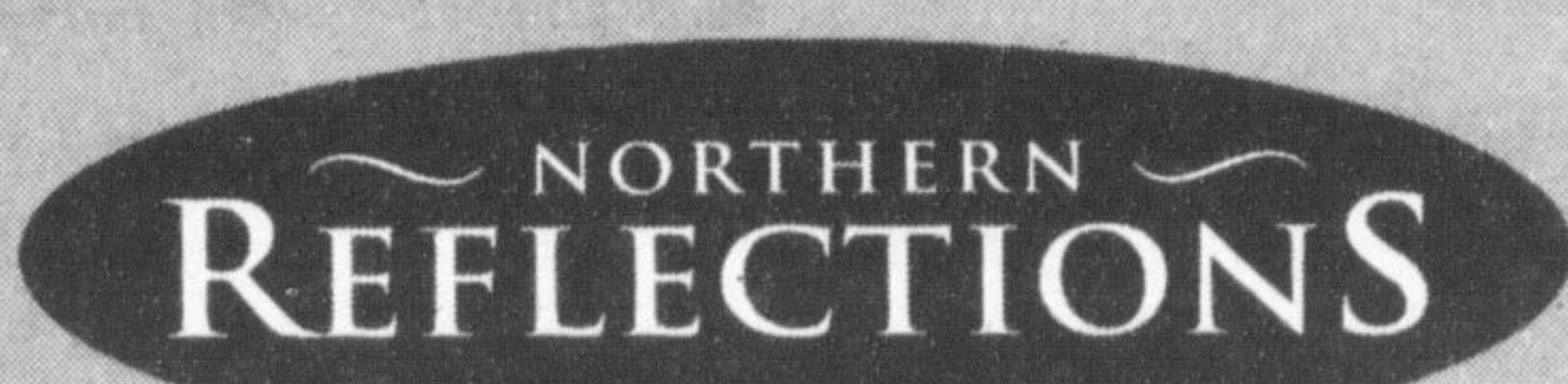
# Meeting to provide info on Community Fund

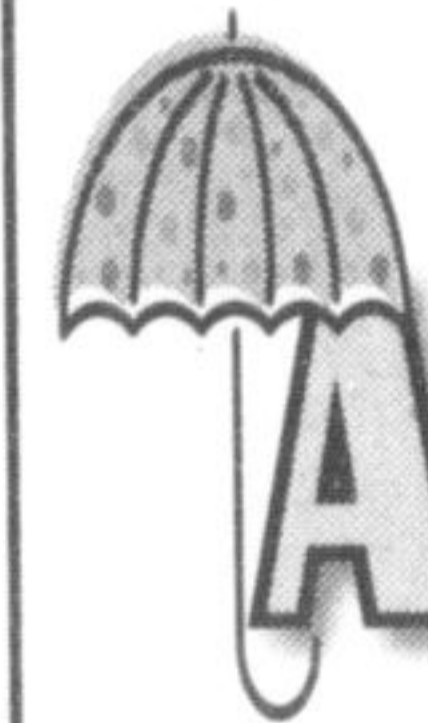
