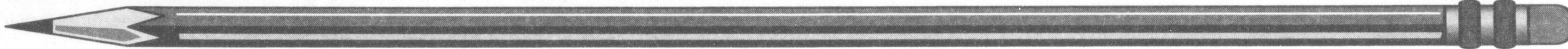


# HIGH SCHOOL REPORT

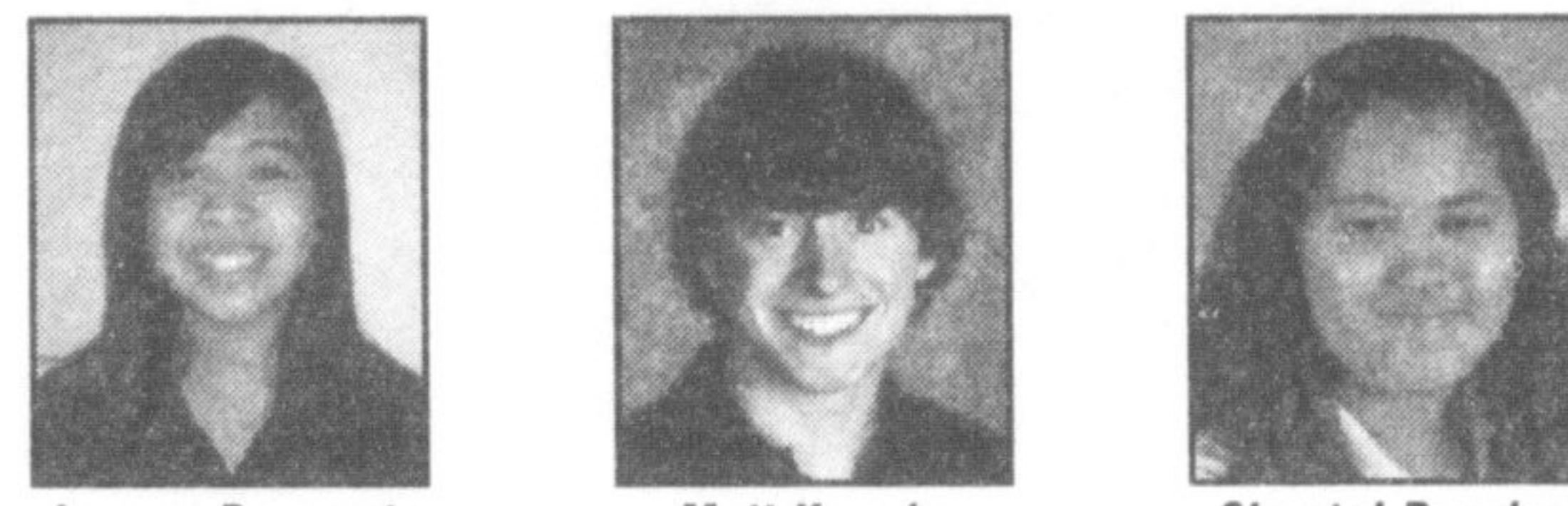
