Police investigating strange encounter

Wednesday morning.

According to police, at about 10 a.m. two female joggers were suddenly confronted by a completely nude man carrying a hiking stick along one of the trail paths.

They jogged past the man and mentioned to him that he'd forgotten his clothes, whereby he replied, "I like it that way."

Investigations continue into When followed by the man, a report of sexual assault at one of the women made it clear Hilton Falls Conservation Area that he was making them uncomfortable and asked him to

He promptly fled after they expressed intentions to call police. A police search of the area was unsuccessful.

suffered Neither woman physical injuries.

The male is described as white, about 40 years of age, six feet tall and 180 pounds, with an athletic build and short dark hair. He was clean shaven and has dark eyes.

Inquest into BMXer's death next month

An inquest will be held into the death of 20year-old Miltonian Tim DaSilva, who died when he was crushed by a roller he was operating while building a BMX track at Halton Place July 15, 2006.

Dr. Dirk Huyer — regional supervising coroner for Central Ontario - announced late last week that the inquest will begin Tuesday, May 27 at the Best Western Inn in Milton.

It's expected to last two days.

Under the Coroner's Act, an inquest is manda-

tory when a worker dies as a result of an accident occurring at a construction project.

The inquest will review the circumstances surrounding DaSilva's death at the Halton Hills farm and the inquest jury may make recommendations aimed at preventing similar deaths.

Prominent and accomplished BMXers, DaSilva and younger brother Chris were overseeing construction of the nearby track at the time of the accident.


