

NOTICE OF FILING OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT

Tremaine Road (Regional Road 22) and James Snow Parkway (Regional Road 4) **Transportation Corridor Improvements**

Town of Milton - Class Environmental Assessment

The Regional Municipality of Halton has carried out a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to address future travel demands on Tremaine Road (Regional Road 22), from Derry Road (Regional Road 7) to Campbellville Road; and James Snow Parkway (Regional Road 4), from west of Regional Road 25 to Dublin Line (see maps below). The study was conducted in compliance with Schedule C of the Municipal Class Environment Assessment (June 2000), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

Following the June 20, 2006 Public Information Centre, the preferred alternative was reviewed in light of comments received and modified as required. Taking into consideration the comments that were received from the Town of Milton, regulatory agencies and the public, Halton Region is recommending the following two Schedule "C" projects:

- The widening and re-alignment of Tremaine Road (Regional Road 22) from two to four lanes from Derry Road (Regional Road 7) to Campbellville Road including intersection improvements, various structures (including a grade separation at CPR track & new Highway 401 Interchange), a roundabout at Main Street and cycling lanes.
- The westerly extension of James Snow Parkway (Regional Road 4), as a four lane roadway, from west of Regional Road 25 to Dublin Line.

The Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared to document the planning and decision making process undertaken for this study and the two recommended projects as noted above. By this Notice, the ESR is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class EA. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of necessary approvals, Halton Region intends to proceed with the detail design and construction of the two projects as documented in the ESR. 
