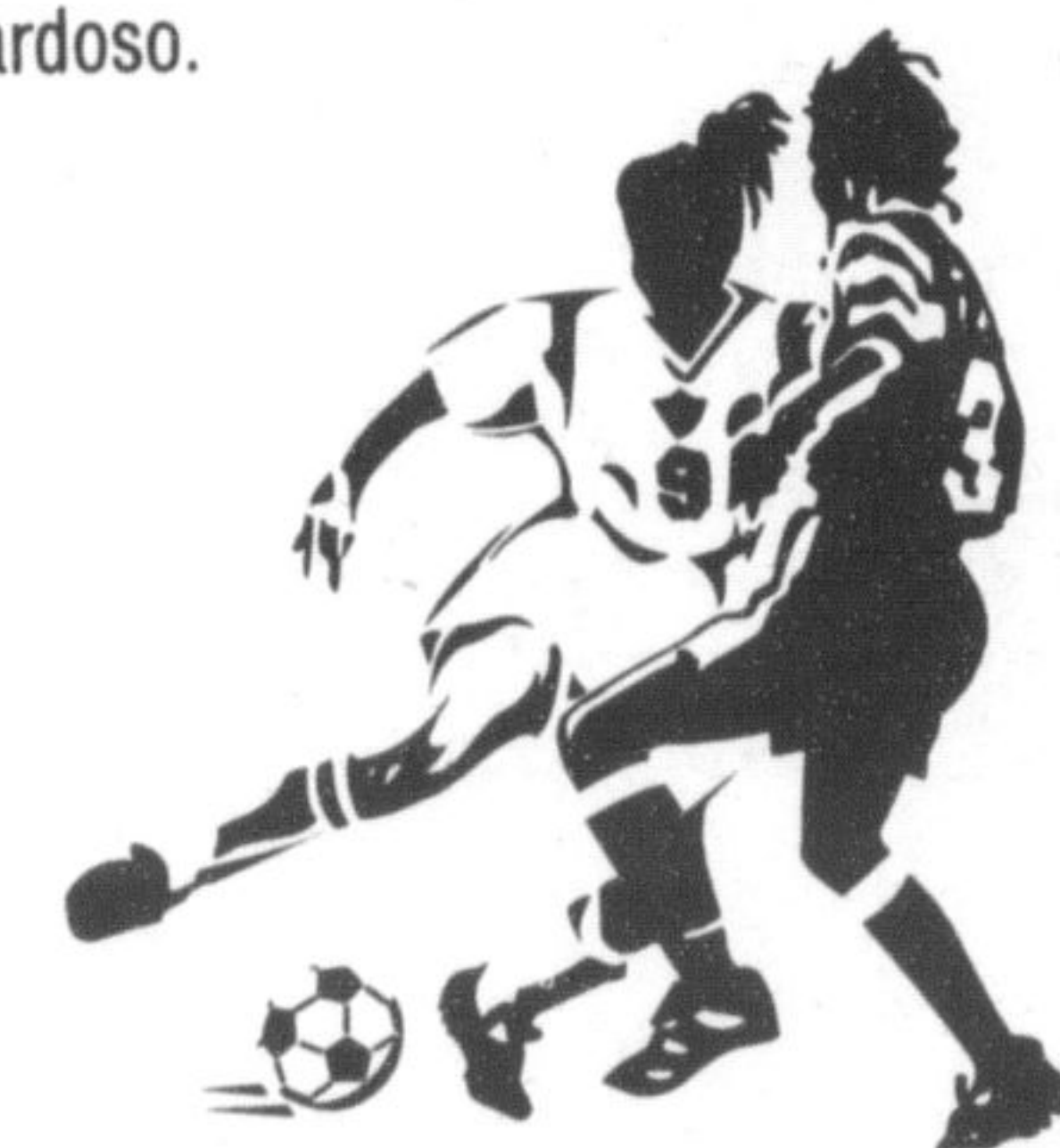
Boston Pizza	3
