As for the 1860s farmstead, it was owned by the Lucas family at a time when farming was starting to change from subsistence farming to market agriculture.

The house was originally located near the corner of Appleby Line and the QEW in Burlington.


The Lucas family, originally from England, bought the farm in 1856. Inside the dining parlor are portraits of

William and Jane Lucas. Their grandson, George Lucas, was the last person to have lived in the house; he died just two years ago.

In addition to the Cassin and Lucas family homes, Country Heritage Park features other buildings and exhibits that'll be open this weekend, and will have ongoing kids' activities such as the Heritage Scavenger Hunt.

Admission to the event costs \$7 for adults, \$6 for seniors, \$4 for kids aged six to 12 and kids under six are free.


