### Notice Of Surplus Lands

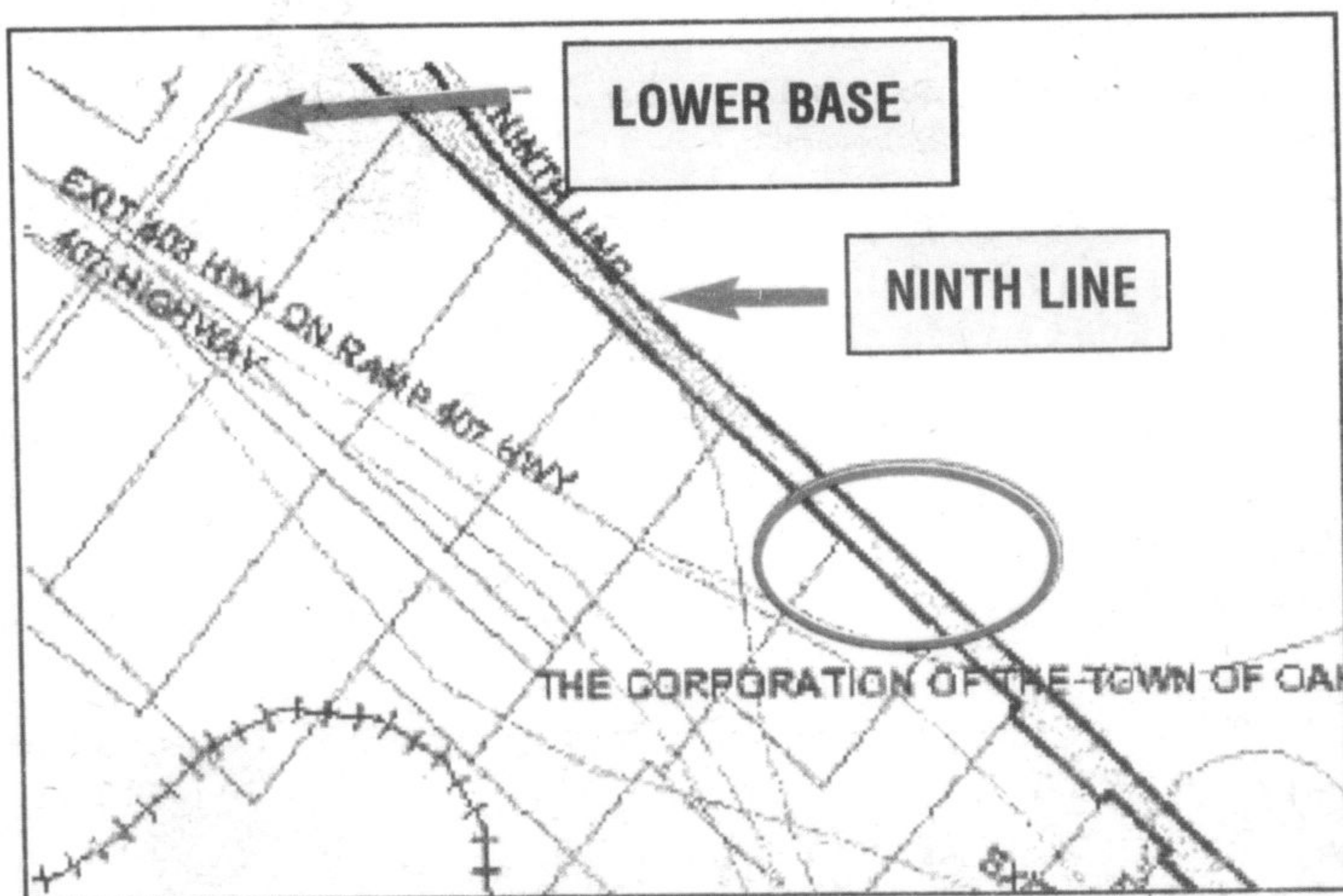
