Road rage fatality suspect returns to court next month

The court case of a Milton man who's been charged in an alleged road rage incident that killed a fellow Miltonian has been remanded.

Wayne Winsor, 39, has been charged with criminal negligence causing death, dangerous driving causing death and failing to remain causing death.

His case came up at Ontario Court of Justice in Milton Wednesday morning and was remanded to September 24, also in Milton.

As the Champion previously reported, 55-year-old Tony Greco died early in the morning July 8 while driving to work.

Police told the Champion Greco had been speeding and "jockeying" with the driver of a Pontiac along James Snow Parkway heading toward Hwy. 401.

Once on the highway, just east of James Snow Parkway, the driver of the Pontiac cut in front of Greco and slammed


Mayor to attend GTMA's Celebrity Golf Tournament
