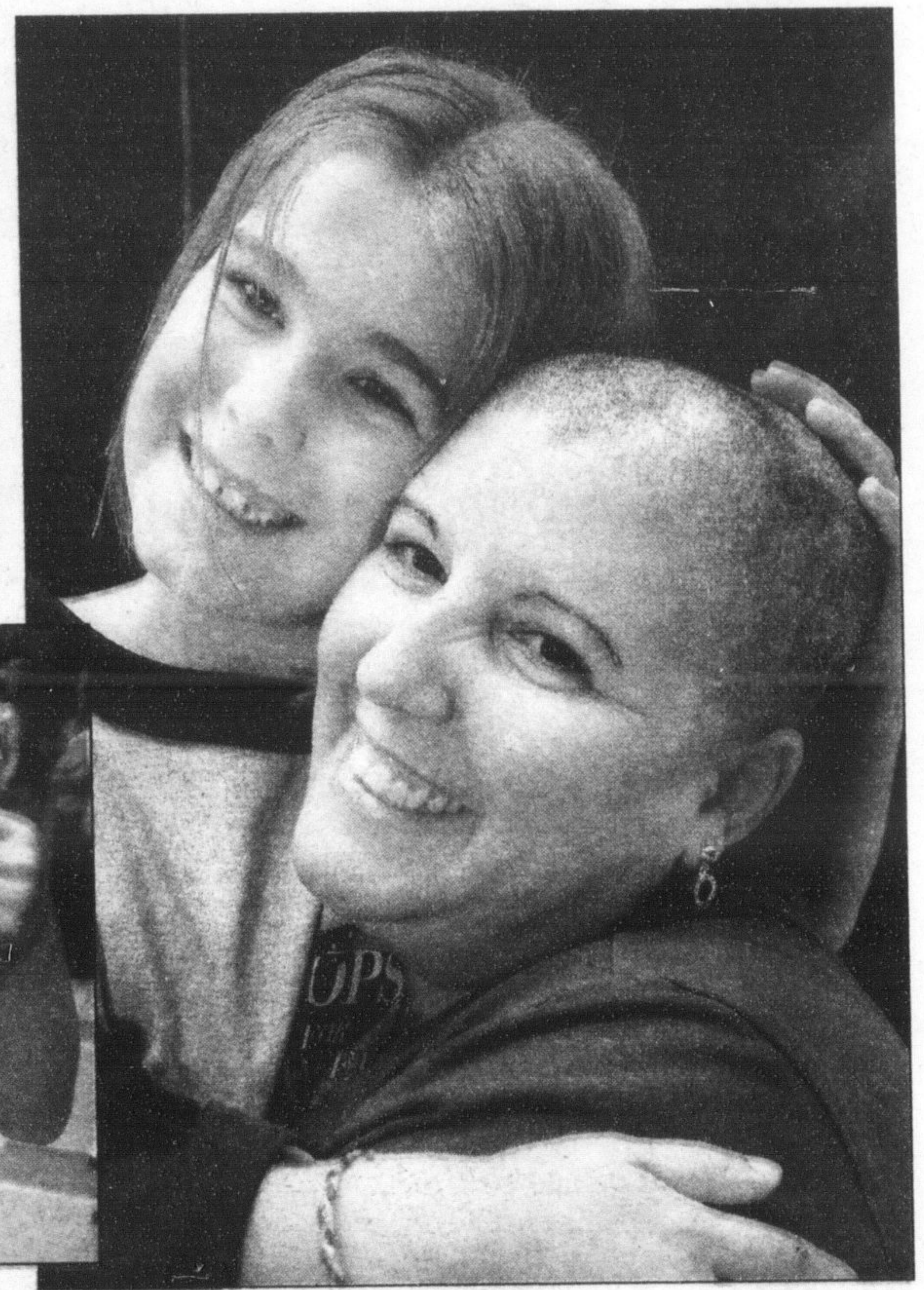
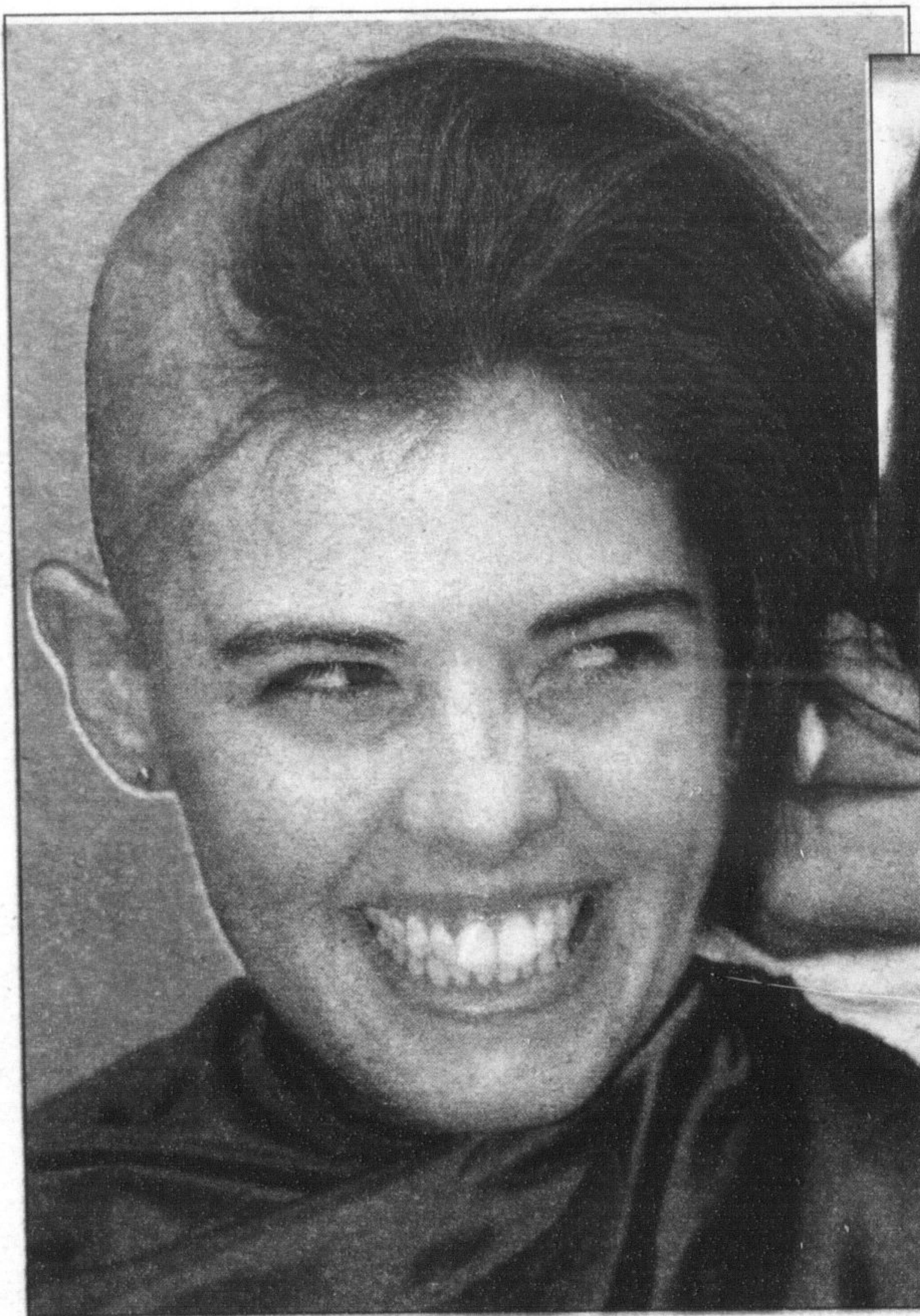


# Cops for Cancer
