NOTICE OF FILING OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT

20 Side Road Realignment from Nassagaweya/Puslinch Townline to west of First Line, Town of Milton Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Regional Municipality of Halton has carried out a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to address safety concerns on 20 Side Road (Regional Road 34) from Nassagaweya/Puslinch Townline to west of First Line (see map below). The study was conducted in compliance with Schedule C of the Municipal Class Environment Assessment (June 2000, Updated 2007), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

Following the December 5, 2007 Public Information Centre, the preferred alternative was reviewed in light of comments received and modified as required. Taking into consideration the comments that were received from the Town of Milton, regulatory agencies and the public, the recommended alternative includes:

 The realignment of 20 Side Road (Regional Road 34) within the study area at the reverse (S-shaped) curve, with a rural cross-section and delineated on-road cycling facilities.

The Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared to document the planning and decision making process undertaken for this study. By this Notice, the ESR is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class EA. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of necessary approvals, Halton Region intends to proceed with the detail design and construction as documented in the ESR. Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order). Requests for a Part II Order must be received by the Minister, at the address below by Monday, October 27, 2008. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Region's Project Manager. If no request is received by Monday, October 27, 2008, Halton Region intends to proceed with detailed design and construction as outlined in the ESR.

She and her staff will be celebrating World Sight Day throughout October with the hopes of raising community awareness and garnering support for


