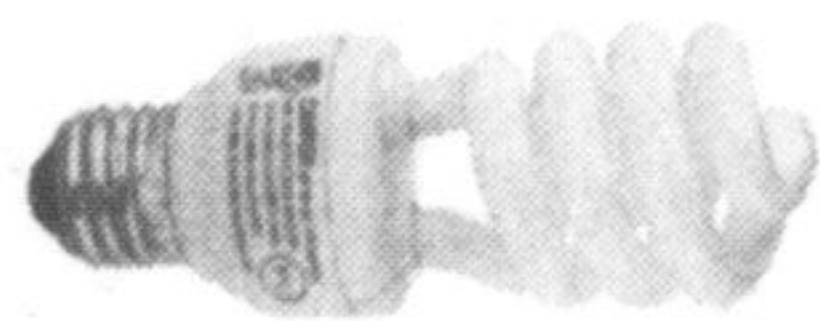


Take It Back! Halton is a directory of local businesses that take back many of the household materials they produce or sell, ensuring materials are reused, recycled or disposed of properly.

Medications



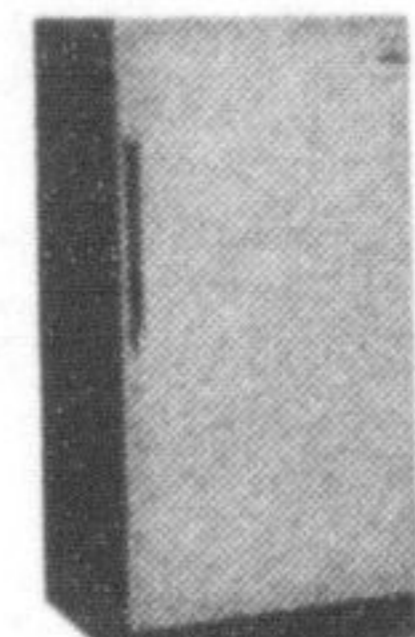

Plastic shopping bags



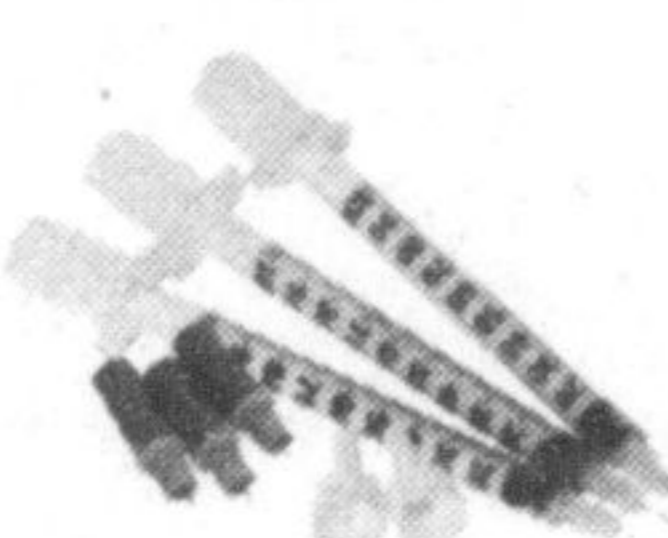

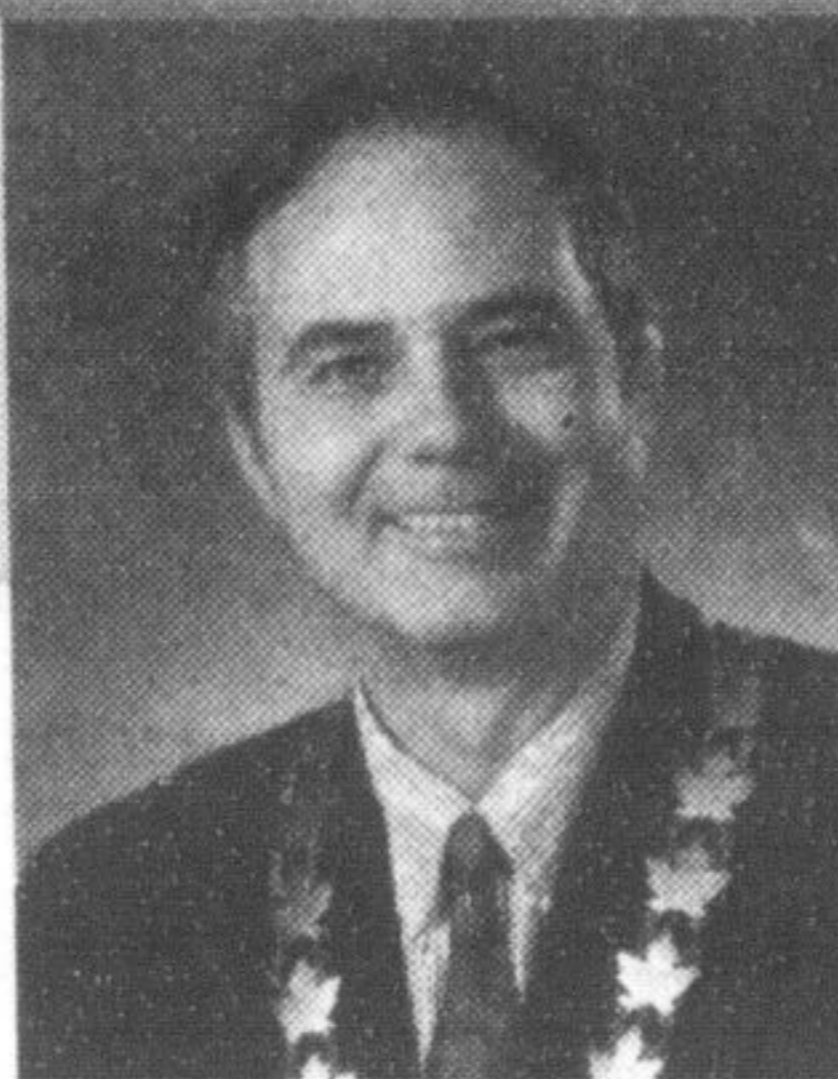

Free Influenza (Flu) Immunizations Throughout the Region

The Halton Region is now offering free influenza immunization to all Halton residents six months of age and older.

Every year, five million Canadians will become sick from influenza, which is a virus that affects the lungs. It can spread easily through coughing or sneezing, or contact with contaminated surfaces (e.g., doorknobs). It can affect anyone, although those with chronic illnesses, young children, pregnant women and seniors are considered high risk for complications. Influenza usually lasts five to 10 days; although some symptoms last several weeks.

The sing-along is part of the celebrations being held this season to mark the Choristers' 40th anniversary.

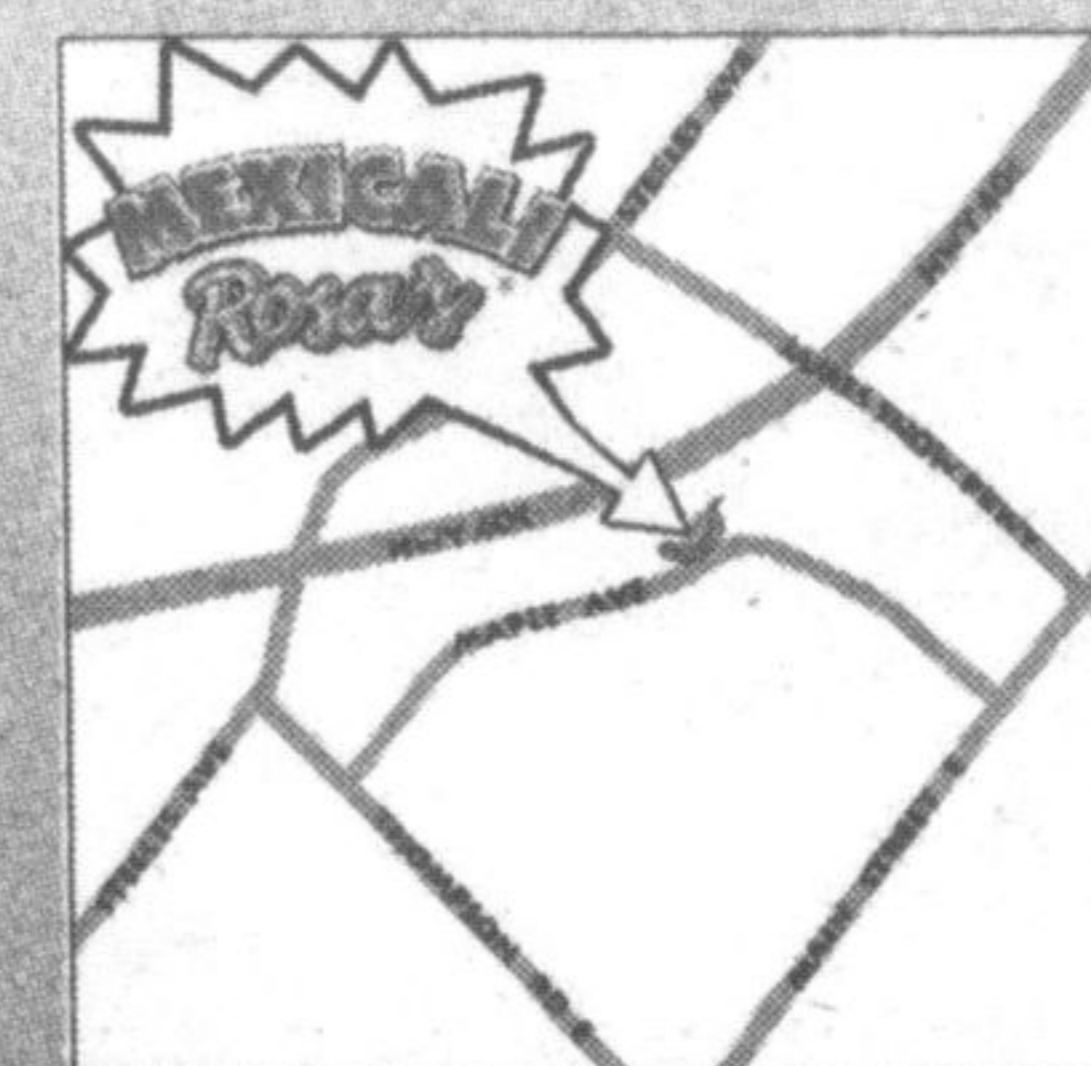
