Tips for potluck partygoers

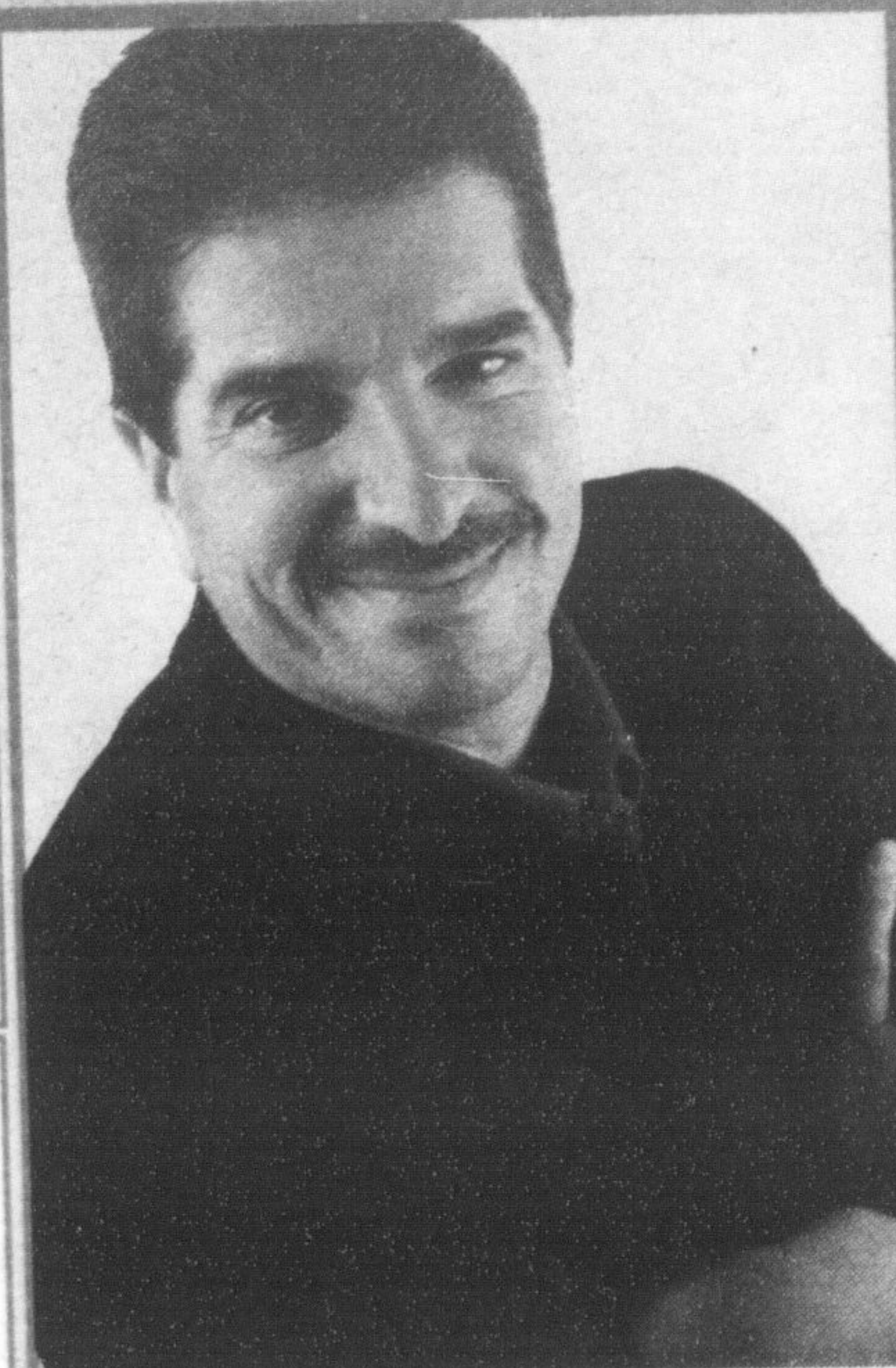

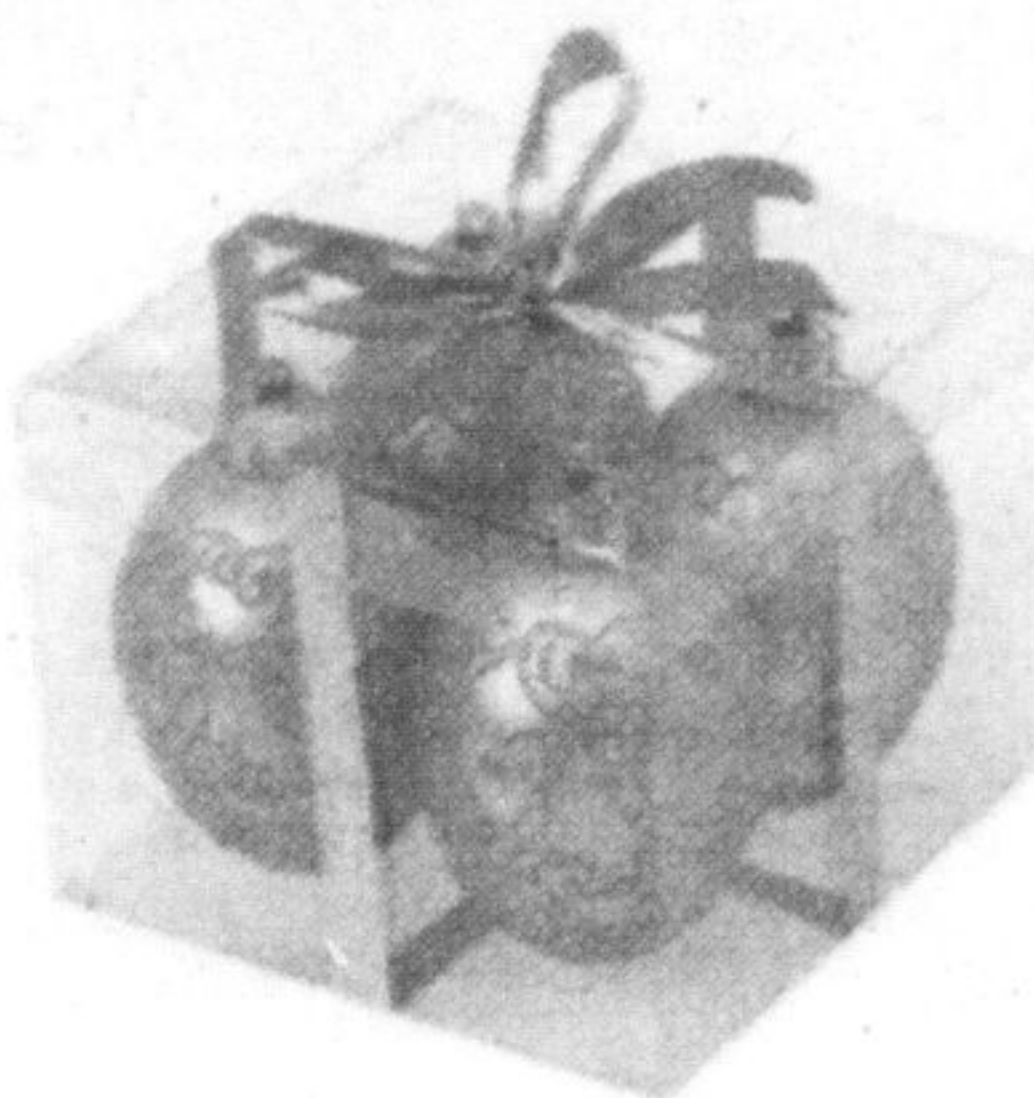
