Dancers set for The Nutcracker

Four young dancers from Milton will take centre stage at an upcoming Christmas production.

Jenna Hadden and Devon Brown, both 11, and Marisa Hadden and Melissa Fay, both 14, will perform in Ballet Jorgen's The Nutcracker, a new version of the beloved holiday classic, set in Canada in 1912.

The Dance Elite students were notified of the honour after successfully auditioning.

They'll perform in The Nutcracker at several GTA theatres, including the Living Arts Centre in Mississauga December 5 and 6 and the Rose Theatre in Brampton December 19 and 20.

Ballet Jorgen Canada is one of North America's premiere ballet touring companies, with more than 200 performances seen by more than 50,000 people each year internationally.

Every year, young dancers from local communities are invited to audition to perform The Nutcracker's children's roles, giving them an opportunity to perform with a professional ballet company.

They receive one-on-one direction from professional dancers and artistic staff, learn about backstage protocol and stage directions, and witness and participate in all that happens backstage before, during and after the performance.
