A much-loved holiday choral classic will be presented tomorrow.

The Milton Choristers will perform Handel's Messiah at 7:30 p.m. at Knox Presbyterian Church, 170 Main St. E.

Although the work was conceived and first performed for secular theatre during lent, it has become common practice since Handel's death to perform Messiah during advent, the preparatory period of the Christmas season, rather than in lent or at Easter.
