# Charges laid after woman, man assaulted on street

A man and woman were assaulted December 2 at the corner of Main and Bell streets in a domestic situation.

Police said a Halton Hills woman and a male acquaintance, from Milton, were walking along Main Street when they were approached at about 9 p.m. by a man known to the woman and a dispute broke out.

No injuries were caused and no weapons were involved.

A 49-year-old Norval man has been charged with assault, criminal harassment, possessing a dangerous weapon, assault with a weapon and uttering a threat in connection with the above incident and incidents dating as far back as February, including one involving a pellet gun.

### Cabbie slapped; suspect sought

Police are looking for a suspect who slapped a cab driver in the GO Transit lot last Friday shortly after 6 p.m.

The driver was flagged down by a man who asked to go to Mississauga. A disagreement broke out inside the cab and the suspect slapped the driver on the back of the head before getting out and fleeing.

The suspect is described as a white male, between 45 and 50

years old, about 181 pounds, and about five-foot-11.

He was wearing a black hooded winter coat with the hood up and was carrying a black bag containing a power drill.

There were no injuries.

### Motorist flees after collision

Police are investigating an incident of a motorist who drove off after striking another driver's car.

Police said a woman was driving westbound on Campbellville Road and had slowed to turn south onto Twiss Road when a vehicle attempted to pass her on the right and struck her vehicle on the passenger side.

The suspect fled, continuing westbound on Campbellville Road.

The suspect's vehicle is described as a red, compact car with white lettering.

About \$1,500 damage was caused to the victim's vehicle.

### Teen arrested following crash

A Milton teen has been charged in connection with an incident in October.

Police said a single vehicle accident took place at Thompson Road and Childs Drive on October 22 and the driver took off.

After further investigation, an arrest was made and a 17-year-old male has been charged with public mischief, failing to stop at the scene of an accident and taking a vehicle without the owner's consent.

### Teens to enter diversion program

Three Milton teens will go through the Halton Regional Police youth diversion program in connection with a break-in last summer.

Sometime between July 11 and 17, a vacant farmhouse on Thompson Road was broken into, with walls spraypainted and other damage caused.

The teens are all 17-year-old males. Charges haven't been laid.

### Salon broken into

A Wilson Drive salon was broken into December 4 and the cash register was stolen.

Police said the incident occurred sometime around 2:30 a.m. at Neo Centrix. The front door glass was smashed by unknown suspects to gain entry.

The register contained an undisclosed amount of cash.

### Vehicle stolen

A vehicle parked on Milborough Line was stolen in the middle of the day Monday.

Police said the vehicle was parked in a driveway and was stolen by unknown suspects sometime between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.

The vehicle is a black, diesel-fueled, 1993 GMC pick-up truck. It has a yellow snowplow attached to it and the word "Meyer" is spelled out in black letters. Its licence plate is 2186WP.

The truck is valued at \$1,500.

### Vehicles broken into

A number of vehicles have been broken into over the past several days.

Overnight December 4, a vehicle parked in a Donnelly Street driveway was broken into by unknown suspects, police said, and a wallet was stolen.

The same night, two vehicles parked in a Tuxford Drive driveway were entered. From the first vehicle, only change was stolen. From the second, which was unlocked, suspects made off with a Magellan GPS unit and charger worth \$300.

Just before 1 a.m. Monday, a Mercedes parked at Mohawk Slots on Guelph Line was broken into. Thieves smashed the window and stole a GPS and a Sony portable CD/MP3 player valued at a total of \$300.

In the same parking lot, sometime between 9 and 11:45 p.m. Monday, a second vehicle had its window broken, and again a GPS,
