

Catholic board finalizes all deals

The Halton Catholic District School Board has ratified settlements with its clerical and technical office employees who are members of Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) 3166, as well as its custodial/maintenance employees who are members of CUPE 2888.

Both agreements cover the four-year period of September 1, 2008 to August 31, 2012.

The settlement covering the board's more than 200 clerical and technical office employees (CUPE 3166) provides for a 3 per

cent wage increase during each year of the four years, as well as non-monetary and housekeeping changes to the current collective agreement.

The agreement with the board's more than 155 custodial/maintenance employees (CUPE 2888) also includes a 3 per cent wage increase during each year of the four years, as well as non-monetary and housekeeping changes to the current collective agreement.

The board has now ratified agreements with all of its unionized employee groups.
