

one to expand service. An additional two more units have been proposed for 2010, subject to the recommendations of the ongoing transit study.

In 2007, about 37 per cent of Milton Transit riders transferred to GO Transit trains or buses. A passenger with a GO ticket or pass only has to pay an additional 50 cents to ride on Milton buses.

All five Milton bus routes wind through neighbourhoods and industrial areas and pass by the GO Station on Main Street, rather than operating on a grid based system with buses running along the same road continuously.
