2009 Budget - Investing in Capital Infrastructure

Regional Council unanimously approved the 2009 budget, raising Regional property taxes by 1.7 per cent. Over the past three years, Halton Region has consistently had one of the lowest tax increases for Regional programs and services in the Province of Ontario. From 2007-2009, the combined average tax increase is less than one per cent.

Given the current economic climate, budget deliberations were rigorous as staff and Council worked to come up with practical solutions in response to the key budget drivers, including investing in capital infrastructure.

The 2009 budget takes into consideration maintaining and replacing existing infrastructure and delivering new infrastructure to support economic development.

Saturday, Feb. 7.


That's when hundreds of area residents are expected to collectively celebrate the Chinese New Year with a dinner and dance put on by the Milton Chinese Association.
