Beloved daughter left to die in ditch: trial

Pretty, blond-haired Lauren Cooper, 18, was known to Rollerblade around her rural subdivision in Nassagaweya.

The night of July 13, 2006, she decided to do just that after putting in a day's work at a daycare centre, and she no doubt enjoyed the warm summer air as it whipped around her ponytail.

Stride by confident stride, she skated around No. 15 Sideroad — at about 10:25 p.m., Stuart

the area. At about 10 p.m., she was back on Second Line, heading south, almost at her driveway. It had been an unremarkable night.

It wasn't an unusual day for her father, Stuart, either, who was enjoying two weeks off work at home with his family.

In the evening he went to a restaurant in downtown Milton with his wife, Deborah, and they walked their dog through 'old Milton' before driving toward home.

But as he neared his house — just north of

noticed Lauren's Rollerblade and flip-flop lying on the road. Deborah noticed a single headlight. They tried to find Lauren inside the house, but couldn't and Stuart went back outside. And there, lying in a ditch metres from the home, he found his youngest daughter.

The sad story of Lauren's death unraveled through the evidence given Wednesday by Stuart at the trial of the man accused of fatally striking Lauren with his pick-up truck and leaving the scene.

Design sped up: art centre

The Town is pushing ahead to develop a concept plan for the proposed \$40-million arts centre and new central library to make it "construction-ready" and eligible for a portion of the \$12 billion in temporary infrastructure funding announced in the federal budget in late January.

Council voted Monday night to speed up detailed design of the facility after the Town received word two weeks ago that a previous application for \$15 million in combined provincial and federal funding for the project had been reject-


