for being fussed over and has always been a source of great comfort for those around her.

"She was strict at times, but she always made time for me when I needed her. I was very well cared for," said son Jeff Barrow, the youngest and only remaining child of four who's also a Miltonian.

Added Jeff's wife Joyce, "She always has a smile and never has a bad word to say about anyone."

The years certainly haven't robbed the Manchester native of her memories.

Gladys still vividly recalls — at the tender age of nine — witnessing the Zepplin raids during the First World War with her Scottish father. And on a much lighter note, recollections of her early encounters with husbandto-be William come seamlessly to mind.

"Oh not at all," she said, when asked if it was love at first sight. "We both worked in the same office and the girls kept telling me not to go out with him because he had a different girl every night."

Those initial reservations would eventually give way to a loving courtship and marriage. While not quite as outgoing as her hubby — who worked in the radio business and later owned some nightclubs — Gladys shared his love of dancing, and the couple could cut a pretty mean rug.

Equally skilled in the kitchen, Milton's newest 100-year-old is perhaps best known among family circles for her culinary creations — which included mouth-watering desserts and homemade breads.

"Her gravy was amazing as well," said Jeff.

"I started cooking when I was 14. My mother was a very good cook as well," said the birthday girl, who lived on her own until last year, when a nasty fall and broken hip forced her to seek full-time care.

The Barrows' history isn't all rosy, though.

Gladys' only daughter, Anne, drowned in a canal when she was just four, and while giving birth to two more children (including Jeff) after a lengthy grieving period, Gladys never had the girl she very much wanted.

And although William escaped more than a few close calls during his time as a corporal in the English Army — during which he twice found himself well within German territory — he died of a heart attack in 1966, cutting their union far too short.

Said Jeff, "Mom's been without him now longer than she was with him."

But Gladys doesn't spend much time dwelling on her losses, choosing instead to embrace her golden years.


While somewhat hard of hearing, she enjoys listening to the radio — specifically AM740 — as well as chatting with family and Allendale staff alike, always with an infectious smile.

So what's her secret to a long life?

"I really don't have a clue," she said with a laugh. "Keeping things simple I guess. I just take it day-to-day and hope for the best."
