Peter Fredrick Smith passed away at his Milton home on Monday April 6, 2009 in the loving arms of his family. 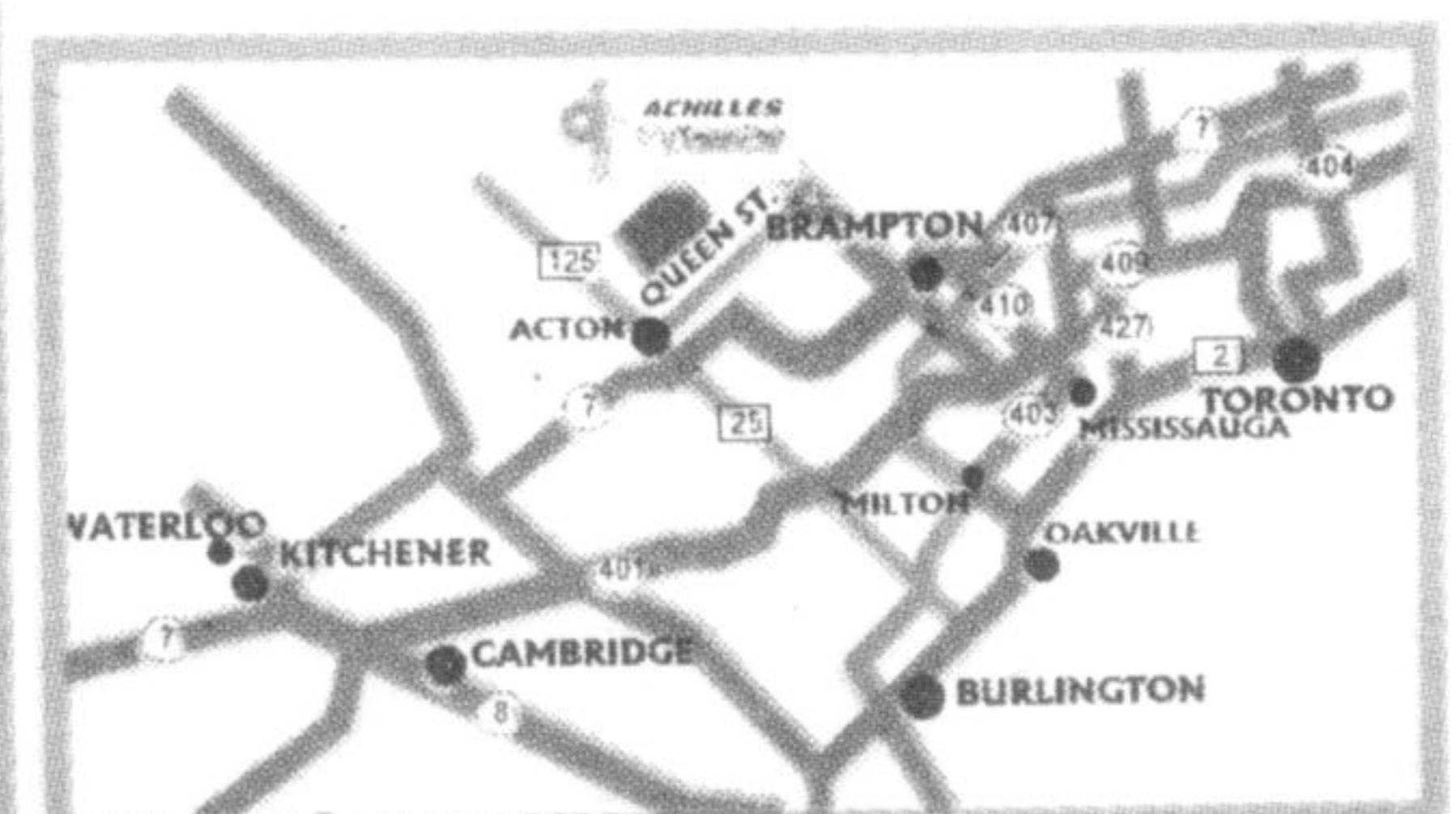
