Three people facing impaired charges

Two women and a man have been charged with drinking and driving in separate incidents, one at dinnertime.

Most recently, a motorist police observed driving erratically at about 2 a.m. yesterday was pulled over. A 32-year-old woman of Bonin Crescent was charged with 'over-80.'

Last Friday at about 3 a.m., police pulled

over a vehicle on Guelph Line. A 43-year-old Guelph woman was charged with impaired driving and 'over 80.'

And the evening of April 20, a vehicle was observed driving erratically on Hwy. 401 and reported to the OPP, who notified Halton police. The vehicle exited the highway onto Guelph Line and was pulled over by local police at Guelph Line and Steeles Avenue just after 5:30 p.m. A 47-year-old Dorchester man was charged with impaired driving and 'over 80.'

Convertible stolen

A Honda convertible was stolen from a Christie Circle driveway overnight Monday.

Police said unknown suspects made off with the two-door, black, 2005 vehicle sometime between 10 p.m. Monday and 5:30 a.m. Tuesday.

The stolen vehicle, worth \$30,000, was

recovered abandoned at 7 a.m. Tuesday in Peel with damage to its ignition. There are no suspects.

Vehicles vandalized

Two vehicles in the parking lot of Milton Chrysler Dodge were damaged overnight last Friday.

Police said unknown suspects smashed the windshield of a Dodge Ram pick-up truck at the Ontario Street dealership as well as damaged a second vehicle.

The combined damage is estimated at \$3,000.

Drugs detected at courthouse

Police made an arrest after drugs were discovered on a visitor passing through the metal detector at the Milton courthouse on Steeles Avenue Monday just after 11 a.m.
