

# National camp awaits Kelly

*Opportunity caps eventful season for defenceman*

Lauren Kelly has once again made the cut.

Extending a breakthrough 2008-09 season that included plenty of highlights and some serious interest from NCAA Division I schools, the 17-year-old Miltonian will be one of 44 players to participate at Hockey Canada's Under-18 women's strength and conditioning/skating camp next week in Calgary.

While realizing this is merely the first step toward a spot on Canada's Under-18 team, the local defenceman was thrilled to learn about her recent invitation.

"Being there with all the top athletes is going to be a great experience," said the Bishop Reding 11th grader. "This is something I really wanted and I was so happy when I found out I'd made it."

Of course that didn't come as much of a surprise to fellow Miltonian Stacey Marnoch, her coach with this year's Stoney Creek Jr. Sabres of the Provincial Women's Hockey League (PWHL).

With home-course advantage, Rattlesnake Point head professional Allan Huibers will look to retain the club's TaylorMade Tournament of Champions crown when the 2009 edition takes place Monday.

Together with men's club champion Brent Rebus and women's champ Mary Miller, Huibers is ready for a strong showing on the Copperhead Course.

The event starts at 11 a.m.

"Lauren's definitely improved this past year, especially in how she thinks the game. She rarely gets beat one-on-one and she's making better decisions now in terms of when to jump into the rush and when to hang back."

One of two Jr. Sabres headed to Calgary, Kelly will be part of a four-day camp (May 7 to 10) involving various fitness tests and skating drills, as well as a number of off-ice sessions — all designed to help Hockey Canada officials better evaluate its high-end prospects and start making decisions for the 2009-10 Under-18 national team.

Though developing into a solid overall blueliner in recent years, the former Brampton Canadette's primary asset continues to be her skating.

"Lauren's got good acceleration and foot speed," noted Brian Hart, head scout of the Ontario Women's Hockey Association. "She has what we classify as STP — the ability to

execute with speed, tempo and pace."

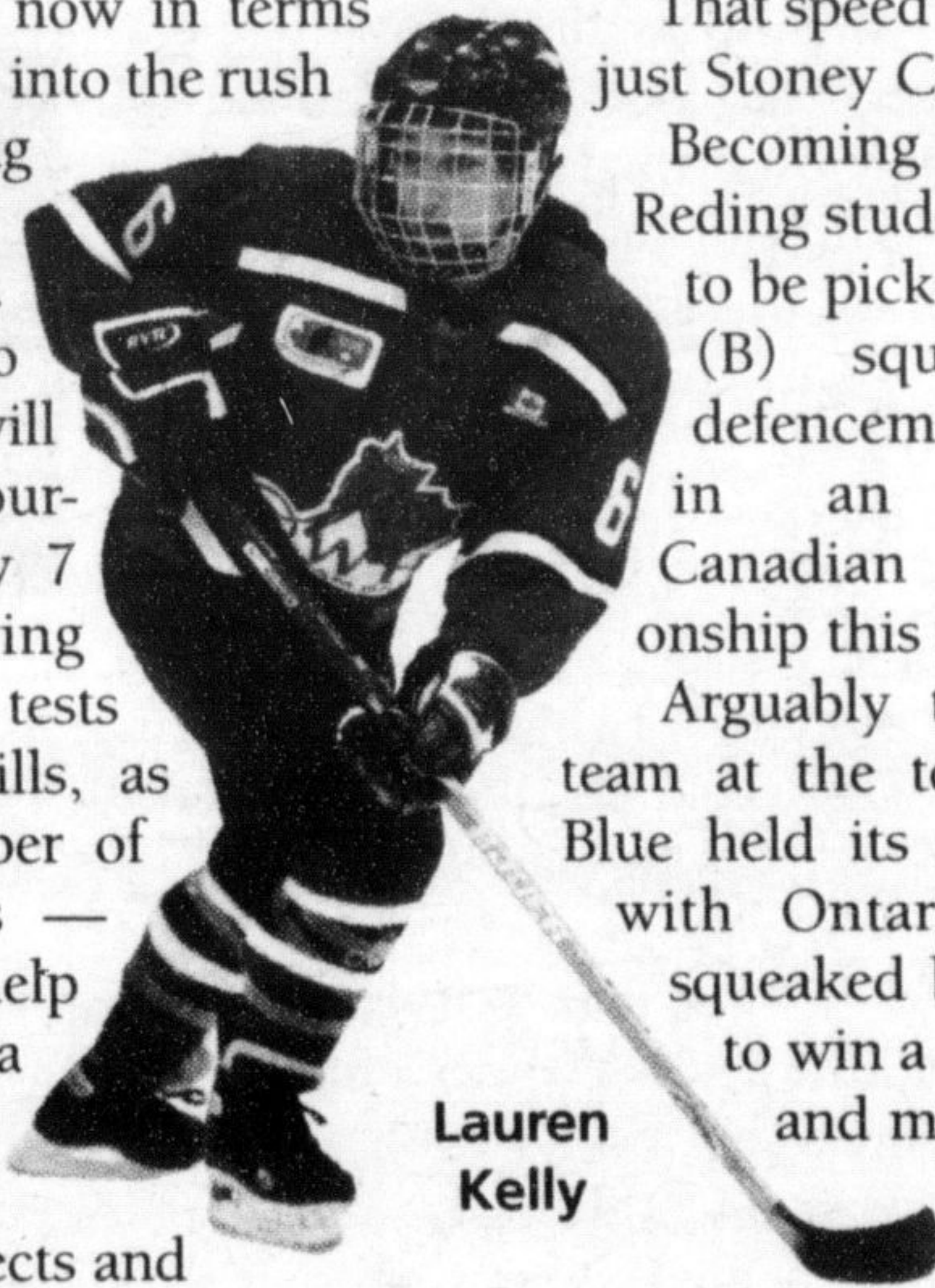
Added Kelly, "Yeah I guess I've always been pretty fast."

That speed benefited more than just Stoney Creek this past year. Becoming the second Bishop Reding student in as many years to be picked for Ontario's Blue (B) squad, the capable defenceman showed strongly in an ultra-competitive Canadian Under-18 championship this past fall.

Arguably the most improved team at the tournament, Ontario Blue held its own in the opener with Ontario Red — which squeaked by 2-1 and went on to win a fifth straight gold — and made it to the bronze-medal game, losing to Manitoba 3-1.

From there, Kelly helped the defensively-sound Jr. Sabres place second in the PWHL and reach the finals at provincials, where a late surge by Mississauga spoiled their championship hopes.

"Big events like that have definitely given me more confidence," said the NCAA-bound blueliner. "This camp is a great opportunity for me to learn and show what I can do."

# Big playoff start for Haydar

Darren Haydar finds himself in awfully familiar territory — namely, around the top of the American Hockey League (AHL) playoff scoring race.

Sitting second as of last night with four goals and six assists, the 29-year-old Miltonian is headed to round two, after his Grand Rapids Griffins dispatched the Hamilton Bulldogs in six games.

Delivering his fourth multi-point game of the still-young post season, the Griffins captain erased an early Bulldogs lead at 5-on-3 and assisted on a last-minute empty netter in Sunday's 4-1 series clincher at Copps Coliseum.

The AHL's top playoff producer three of the past five years, Haydar had at least one point in five of the six games.

His plus-5 rating against the Bulldogs is also encouraging, since he'd struggled at even strength through much of the regular season despite finishing sixth in scoring with 31 goals and 49 assists.

Haydar now squares off against former teammate and good friend Jason Krog, who led the Manitoba Moose to an overall first-place finish and a six-game win over the Toronto Marlies.

Grand Rapids and Manitoba begin the North Division Final tonight.
