



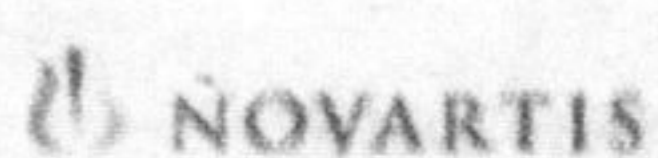

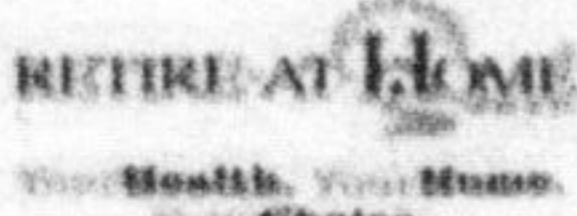

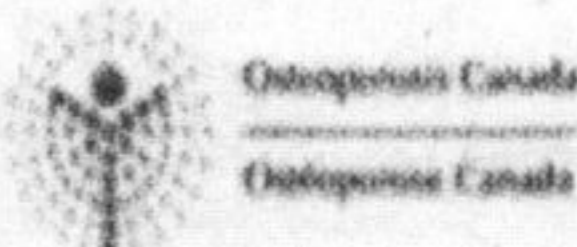

DEVELOPMENT CHARGE AMENDING BY-LAW

Timing of Indexing of Development Charge Rates

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Halton Regional Council at its April 1st, 2009 meeting directed staff to undertake a Development Charge (DC) process under the Development Charges Act, 1997 to amend the timing of the indexing of the Regional DC rates under DC By-law No. 62-08. Currently, the Regional DC rates are adjusted on April 1st of each year.

"The Halton Development Charge Background Study related to Indexing of Development Charges" will be available to the public on **Wednesday, May 13, 2009**, and can be obtained at the office of the Regional Clerk at 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville, Ontario, L6M 3L1.

Public Meeting

The Development Charges Act, 1997 requires that at least one public meeting be held prior to the passing of an amendment to a development charge by-law. The purpose of this public meeting is to present the proposed amendment related to the timing of the indexing of the Development Charge rates.
