Nipissing University in partnership with the Ministry of Education will be hosting their third annual ASL Immersion Camp this summer. This two week camp is for teachers interested in pursuing Qualifications in Teaching Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children Ontario and currently enrolled at Nipissing University as well as for teachers and other related professionals currently employed with Provincial Schools who are interested in improving their ASL skills. This years camp will also host a one week Teen program for Hard of Hearing and Deaf students across Ontario who are interested in developing skills in ASL. The Adult camp runs from July 12, 2009 - July 24, 2009 utilizing the Ernest C. Drury Campus facilities in Milton, Ontario. The Teen Camp runs for one week from July18th-24th, 2009.

If you are looking for an exciting and unique opportunity to work in an academic and recreational setting, come and participate at our camp! Bring your skills and experience, creativity, leadership skills and participate in this adventure. We are seeking dedicated individuals for the following positions (Exact days of work and hours vary depending on the position)

Two Week Positions: July 10 - 24, 2009

Camp Director (1 position) -The Camp Director responsibilities include active participation in the interview and hiring of camp staff, as well as program development and implementation, supervision of all programs (Adult and Teen), including ASL classes, trips, evening activities, the ASL instructors and Teacher Models. The chosen candidate must have proven leadership abilities, knowledge of program development, excellent communications skills and proficiency in ASL

Operations Coordinator (1 position) - The Operations Coordinator will participate in the hiring process for camp staff. He/She will also manage the camp residential facilities and supervise residential counselors and Up night Staff. The successful candidate will also be responsible to oversee the general operations of the camp including kitchen, cleaning staff as well as all financial requirements. The chosen candidate must have good leadership skills, knowledge of ASL, experience with budgeting and ordering of supplies. Experience Working in a residential setting an asset.

ASL Instructors (5 positions) - will provide instruction and certification of the Signing Naturally Curriculum. You must be a native or near native signer and have experience as an ASL instructor and course coordinator. Classes will run on average for 6-7 hours per day and will include classroom instruction; assessment and evaluation and activity based learning. The chosen candidates must possess previous experience teaching ASL to hearing individuals.

Interpreters - ASL/English (4 positions)- The interpreter positions are full time positions with varied/ flexible hours including some evenings and some weekend requirements. The successful candidate must be willing to work in a team setting, and have well developed receptive and expressive sign language skills (ASL and other forms of manual communication) combined with experience with deaf individuals.

Cook (1 position)- will plan and over the preparation of breakfast, lunch and dinner, prepare menus and order supplies. You will have practical cooking experience for a large group; familiarity with kitchen equipment and provide group leadership to kitchen staff. Experience working in a large volume food services environment and knowledge of food handling/ preparation techniques and sanitation standards. Knowledge of ASL recommended.

Kitchen Helper (3 positions)- will assist in the preparation and service of meals. You will maintain cleanliness of food service area, equipment and utensils. Experience working in a large volume food services environment and knowledge of food handling/preparation techniques and sanitation standards. Proficiency in ASL an asset.

One Week Positions: July 17 - 24, 2009

Residence Counsellors (4 positions) - will supervise students (Teen Campers) from 3:00 - 11:00pm daily (Monday -Friday) and 8:00am - 11:00pm Saturday and Sunday (July 18 and 19). The successful candidates will be proficient in ASL, have experience working in a residential setting and have demonstrated excellent interpersonal skills and knowledge working with youth.

UP Night Staff (2 positions) - will work during Teen Week only supervising students in the residence overnight. Hours of work are 10:30pm to 7:30am. The successful candidate must have experience working in a residential setting, and will be expected to remain awake during the working hours. Proficiency in ASL an asset.

Teacher Models (3 positions) - will work during Teen Week only. The successful candidates for this position must be qualified Teachers of Deaf and Hard of Hearing Students in Ontario with a minimum of 5 years teaching experience. These Teacher models will act as Host Teachers for the teacher candidates within the program as they work towards their teaching practicum requirements.


