The large homebuilder Mattamy proposes to build 1,257 housing units on 68 hectares from the farmstead to the future extension of Louis St. Laurent Ave. Its proposal envisions maintaining the property in a neighbourhood park to be given to the Town, meaning the municipality would essentially become the landlord.

At a recent public meeting on Mattamy's development application, Ward 4 Councillor Paul Scherer asked Town staff to report back on what the municipality intends to do with

The question then will be what to do with the property and how much it will cost to maintain the buildings.

> "Historic buildings are best served when they're well used," said Scherer. "It's a gor-

geous building and we've got to figure out what to do with it."

· The property was bought by Austin Willmott, who was said to be "a diligent and prosperous farmer" and prominent Methodist Church member, along with his by William Edwin Brooks, whose son Allan was a well known ornithologist and artist.

· The farmhouse has two distinct wings. The rear wing was the original farmhouse and was built in the 1840s. The front wing is a two-storey brick section

built in 1856 with reportedly an "unusually fine and sophisticated Greek Revival design." The large red board and batten barn dates from 1912 and is significant for wife, Jane. The property was later owned its use of hollow clay tiles in its founda-

> • There's evidence suggesting Wilmott owned the land since the early 1820s. The original farmhouse is one of the few remaining original houses of a Milton pioneer family in the former Trafalgar Township.




