

Meeting on park designs Wed.

A public meeting will be held Wednesday evening to help decide on a preferred concept for the redevelopment of Brian Best Park, located at Commercial Street beside Milton District High School.

The Town is also gathering online feedback on various designs for two new neighbourhood parks — Harrison, located between Scott and Savoline Boulevards north of Dymott Avenue on the west side of

town; and Coates South, located at Clark Boulevard and Philbrook Drive.

The Town will gather public input on the redevelopment, which will help guide the final design work to be done next year, pending budget approvals. Following the meeting, the design concepts will be posted on-line for public feedback until July 2.
