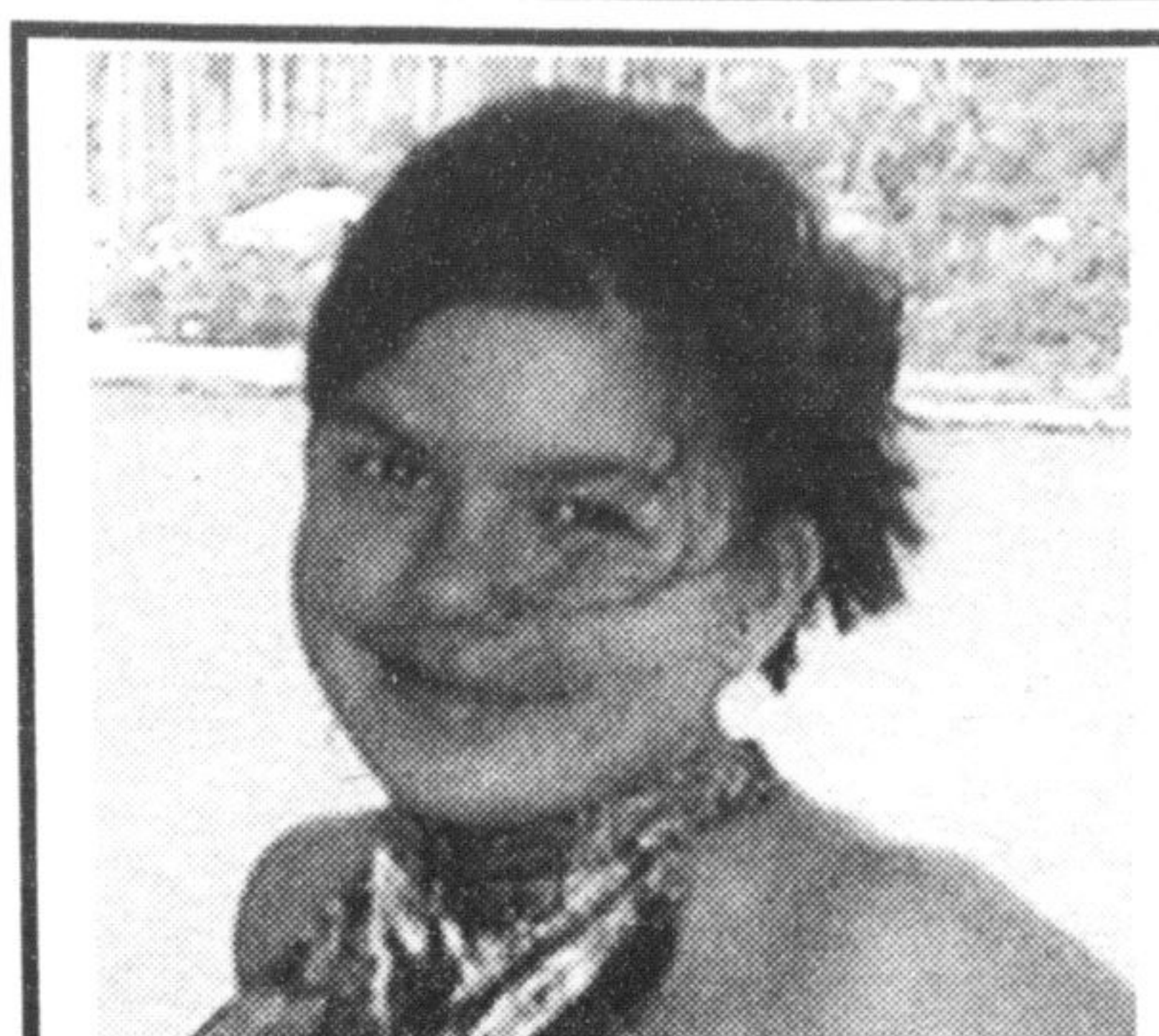

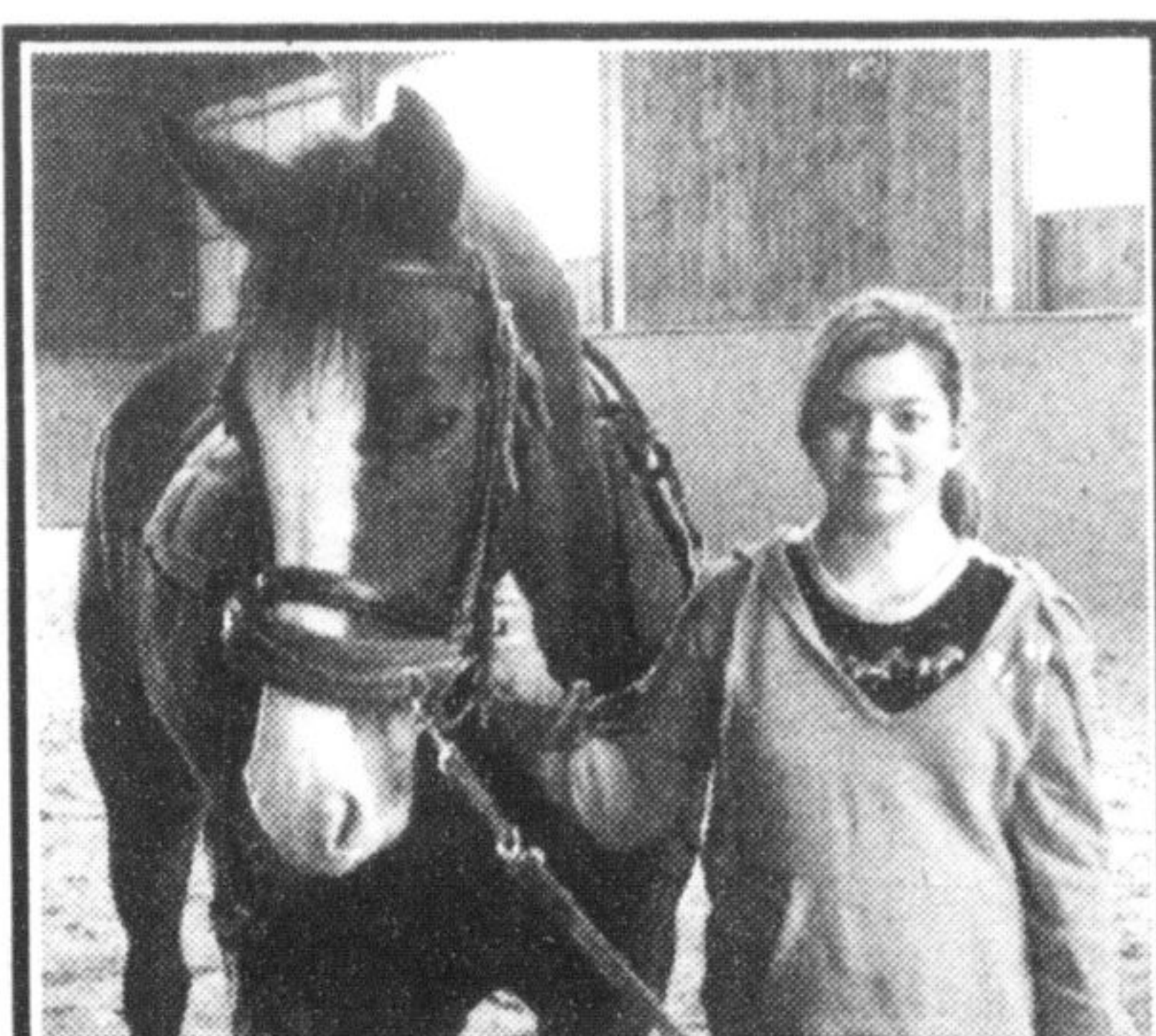
In Memoriams
