

## Volunteer tree planters needed

The time to sow the seeds of rebirth is fast approaching.

Partnering with the Town of Milton on Trees for Watershed Health for the next two years, Conservation Halton (CH) invites area residents to join a team of nearly 400 volunteers to plant 4,000 trees at the Kelso Quarry this Saturday.

The planting — at the quarry just off of Steeles Avenue, adjacent to Kelso Conservation Area — will take place from 9 to 11:30 a.m.

The event is open to individuals, families and groups who pre-register at [www.conservationalton.ca](http://www.conservationalton.ca). Spaces tend to fill up early, so register as soon as possible.

"The Trees for Watershed Health planting is a highlight of our spring calendar every year. It's wonderful to see the community participation," said CH Director of Communications Services Hassaan Basit. "This year, we are pleased to be celebrating the International Year of Forests and helping to contribute to the forest cover in the watershed."

Volunteers are reminded to dress according to the weather, wear waterproof boots and bring a shovel. The event runs rain or shine, and those wishing to be part of the morning planting should register by the end of today.
