

Personating peace officer charges laid against man

A 50-year-old Peel resident was charged with two counts of personating with intent, two counts of personating a peace officer and one count of uttering threats after a man allegedly made phone calls to a Milton doctor's office and pharmacy in relation to another patient.

The suspect was arrested after a week-long investigation by police.

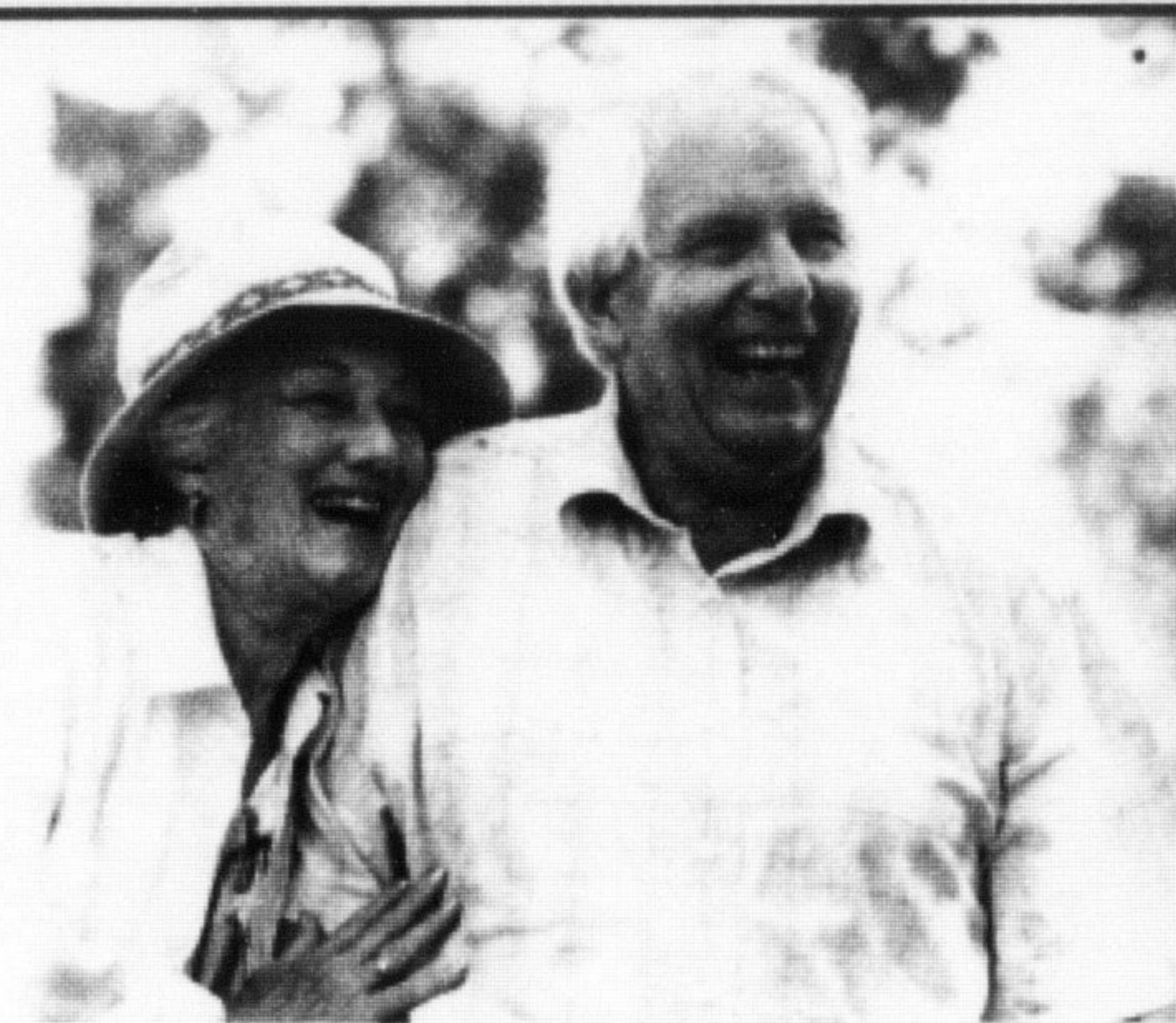

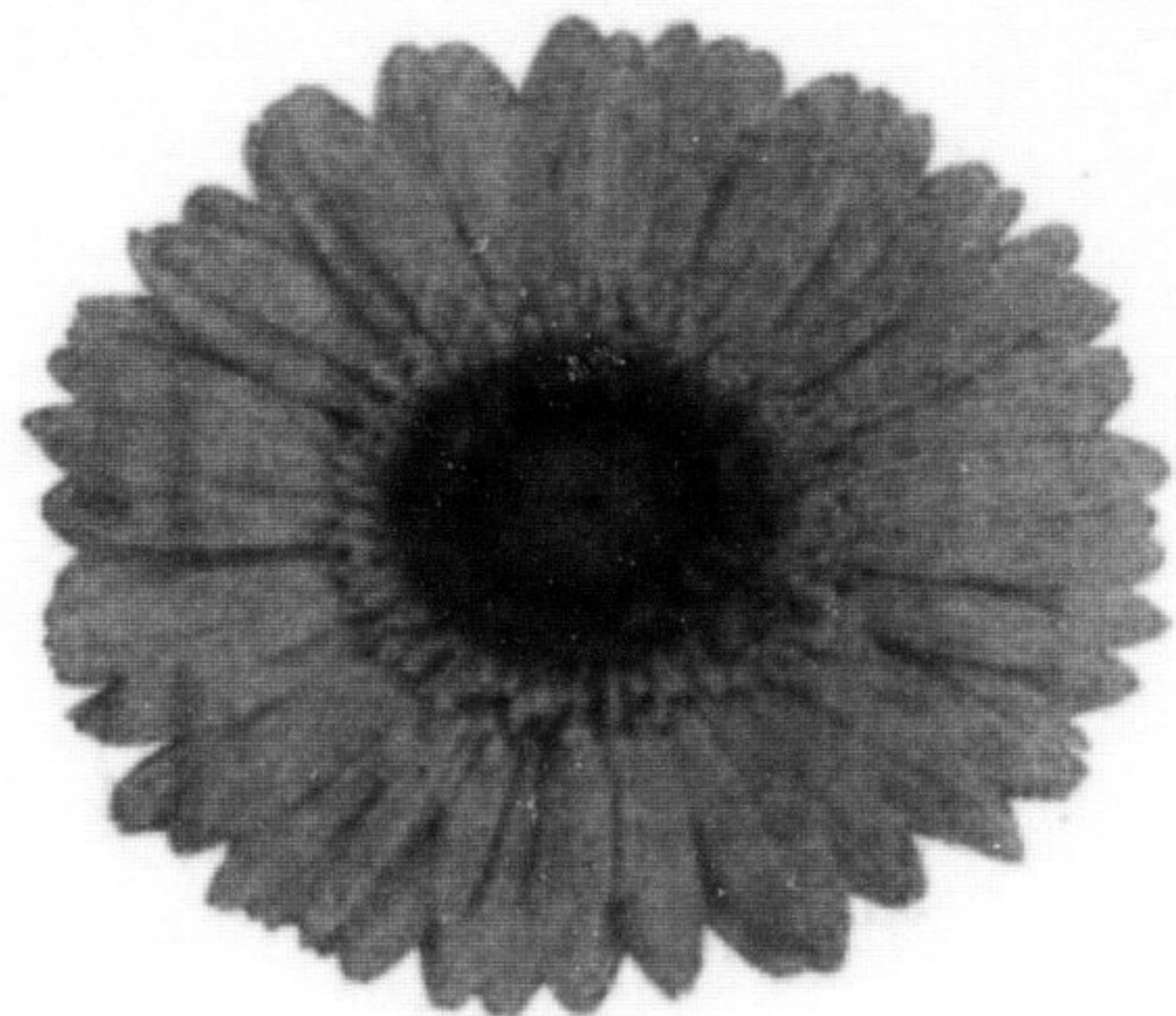
