## Temporary Road Closure Fourth Line – Beaty Trail to Menefy Place

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 11(3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, that Community Services Standing Committee of the Town of Milton will consider the adoption of a bylaw(s) authorizing temporary road closure for MTE Consultants Inc. to complete road improvements including culvert installation on Fourth Line from Beaty Trail to Menefy Place.

The temporary closure will be in effect from **October 17, 2011** until **November 25, 2011**. Local and emergency access will be maintained throughout the construction.

Habitat for Humanity Halton is once again getting in the swing of things.

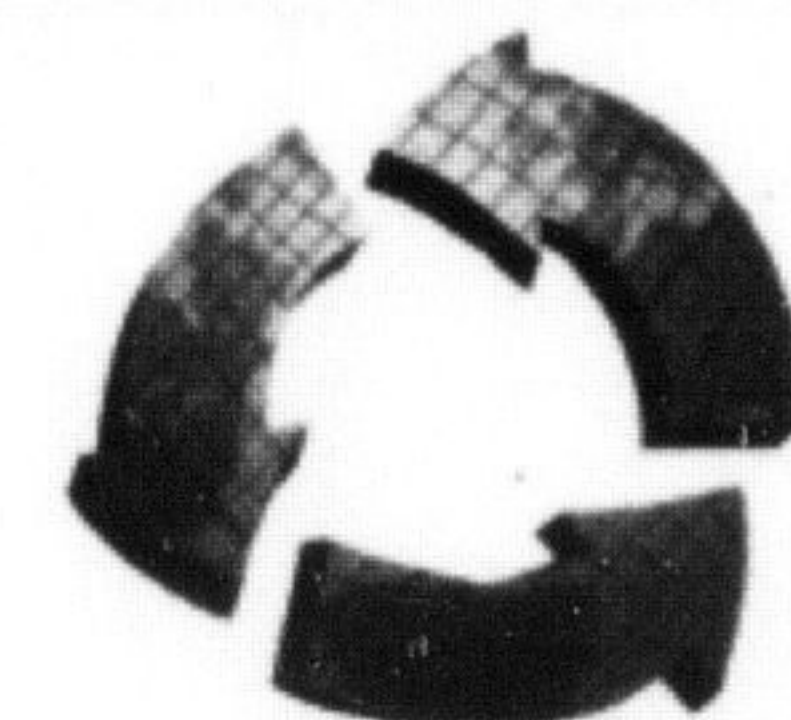
Partnering with Prosperity ONE this year, Habitat will hold its 27th annual charity golf tournament next Tuesday at Granite Ridge Golf Club.
