**Family tops list of issues, says Rodrigues**

The Canadian Champion has asked Halton riding's seven candidates three questions it feels are of the utmost importance. The responses from those who participated in the questionnaire are being published in Champion editions leading up to the October 6 provincial election. Here are the responses from Family Coalition Party candidate Tony Rodrigues.

**Champion:** What's the most pressing election issue for Milton and Halton residents and why?

**Rodrigues:** The family, the family, the family. It's in the family that we learn to be responsible to ourselves and everyone around us. If we concentrate on family, we won't have



homelessness.

**Champion:** The Town of Milton and Halton Region have opposed any new highways cutting through environmentally-sensitive land. How will you and your party address the GTA West and Niagara to GTA corridors proposed by the Province and how does your party plan to meet transportation needs in the area?

**Rodrigues:** The Niagara highway has been on the books for 20 years. No one could do anything about it because nobody had the will. I'm in favour of building new roads, but let's be realistic. Why in the world did we build Hwy. 407 and then sell it for a fraction of the money the highway cost? Why spend more taxpayer money to build another

highway that we need, but then why do we have to pay for the 407? Buy back the 407 and let the people use it for free, or put a toll on the 407 and use the money to expand it. You won't address all the congestion, but it would be a step in the right direction.

**Champion:** Milton has been promised an expansion to its aging hospital and the Town is eager to start development on the Milton Education Village. How will you and your party ensure these projects break ground in a timely manner, keeping the provincial deficit in mind?

**Rodrigues:** Allow the aggregate companies to dig limestone on the escarpment, but as long as they build us a state-of-the-art hospital. Do you know how many trillions of dollars there are in Halton because of limestone deposits? As for the university, I'm not happy with the site they chose. For future generations of Canadians the university should be built on top of the escarpment, because it's one of the best views that we have. Unless we make a national park, the developers will keep an eye on that land, so if we build a university there, it's an asset.
