

Sprint racer back on track with strong showing

Rebounding from his worst finish of the season — 13th — the previous weekend, Campbellville's Kevin Job and his 21x sprint car racing team delivered a sixth-place performance at Ohsweken Speedway last Friday night.

Now in his second year in the dirt after a stint on Flamborough's Pro 4 circuit, the rural racer won his heat for a second straight week and then moved up five spots from his 11th-place starting position in the 25-lap feature.

This marked the fifth top-10 effort in seven starts for Job, who now sits third in the series points race.

More than two dozen cars are part of the

sprint car scene at Ohsweken (near Native reserve in Brantford), which holds racing nearly every weekend through the late spring and summer.

Highlighting the siblings' weekend was young David, who breezed through his motos and followed that up with a second-place finish in the nine-year-old male main event.

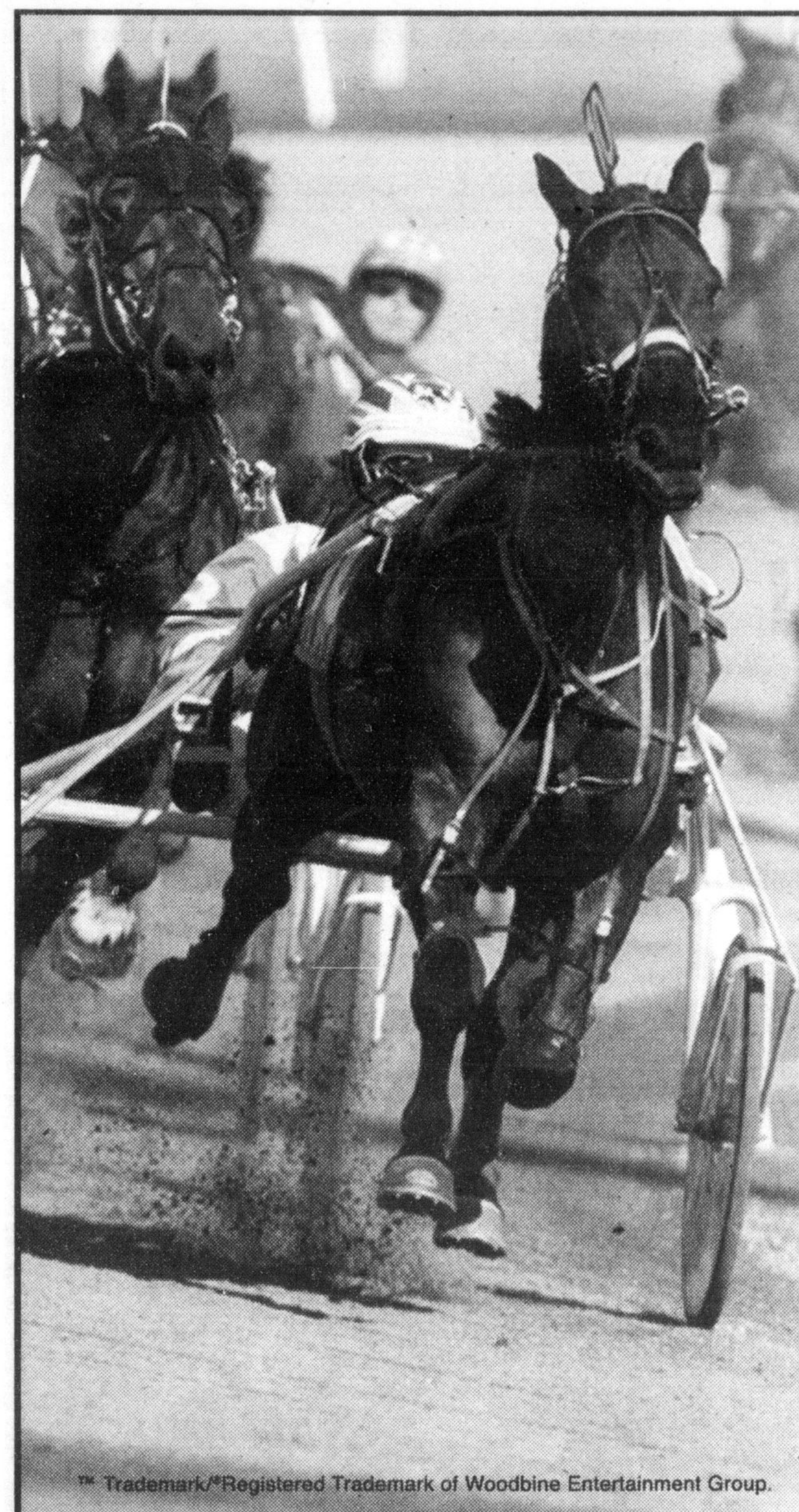
Kaitlyn took fourth-place honours in the

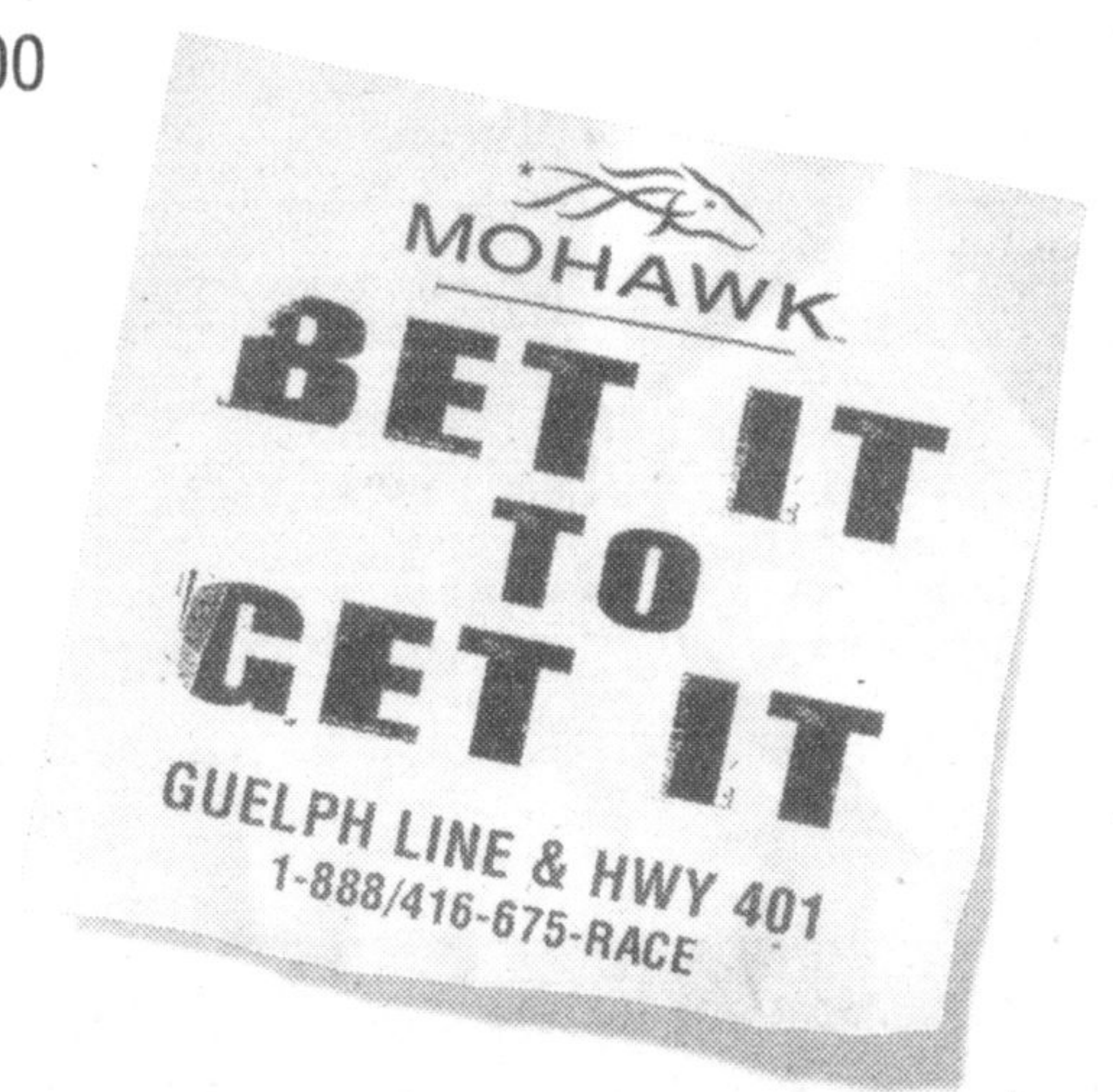
