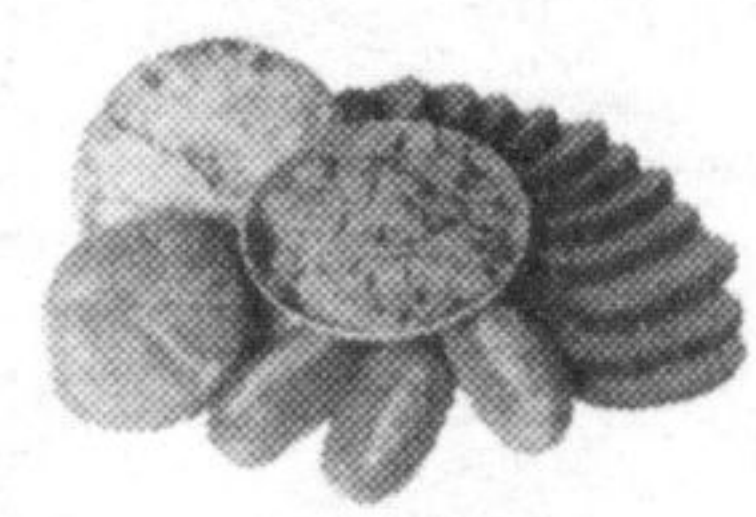
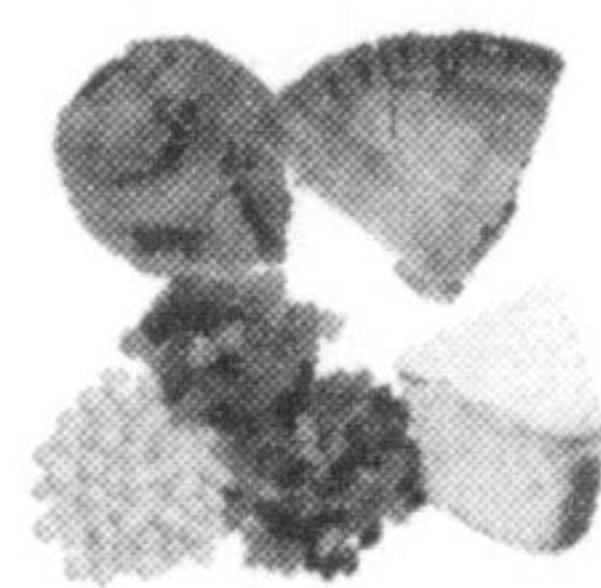

✓ GreenCart Acceptable Materials



Bread, toast, cereal, baked goods & pizza



Cake, cookies, pie, muffins & candies



Coffee grounds & filters, teabags



Dairy products, cheese & yogurt (no containers)



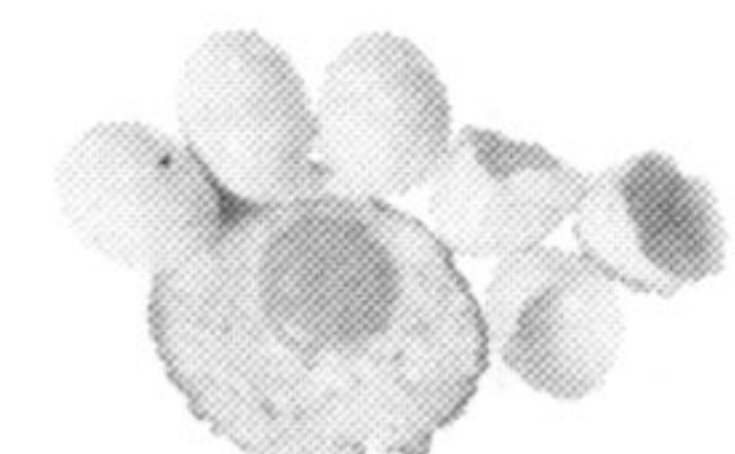
Houseplants



Meat, fish & shellfish (including bones)



Pasta, couscous, potatoes, rice, oatmeal, flour & grains



Eggs & egg shells



Soiled paper towels, facial tissues, paper towel rolls and toilet paper rolls



Vegetables, corn cobs & husks, nuts & shells, pumpkins & salads



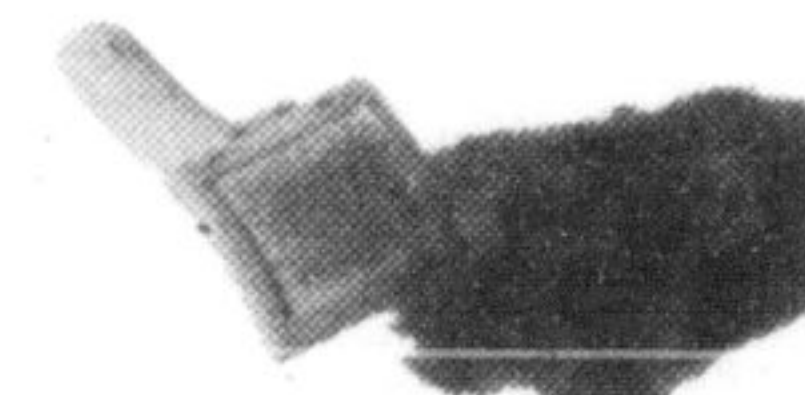
Fruit



Sauces, mayonnaise, salad dressing, syrups, peanut butter, jams & jellies (no containers)



Fats & oils, lard, gravy, butter & margarine (no containers)



Hair, pet hair, feathers, nail clippings and dryer lint



Soiled paper food packaging, popcorn bags, cardboard egg cartons, greasy pizza liners, paper plates & cups, cardboard take-out food trays and containers

✓ GreenCart Acceptable Liners

It's up to you whether you line your GreenCart or not. If you choose to line your GreenCart, here are the acceptable liners:

- newspaper/flyers
- paper towels
- cardboard
- paper bags
- paper food waste bags
- certified compostable bags with the Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI) logo:



Bags that display the BPI logo are designed to compost quickly and safely when composted in a commercial composting facility.



The following bags are **not** accepted and will not be collected:

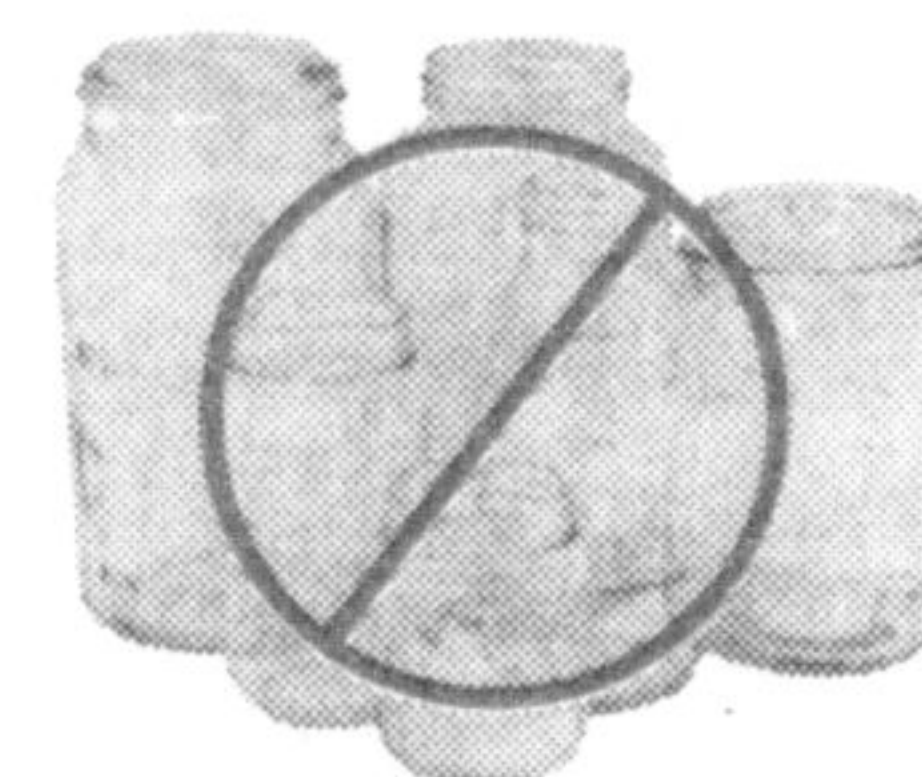
- plastic shopping bags, including ones that say "oxo-degradable"
- green plastic "recycling" bags
- plastic garbage bags
- clear plastic fruit & vegetable baggies

By excluding these plastic bags, we supply the composting facility with a clean material, resulting in a higher quality final compost product.

Cleaning out your fridge?

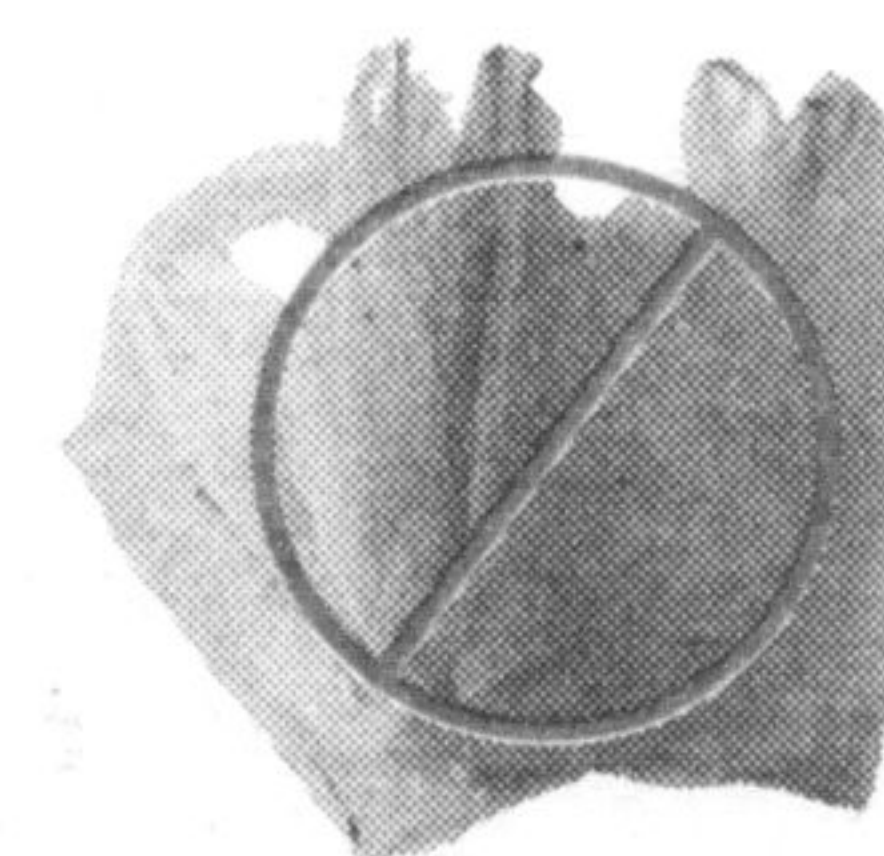
Ensure the following items do **not** go in the GreenCart as they will not compost:



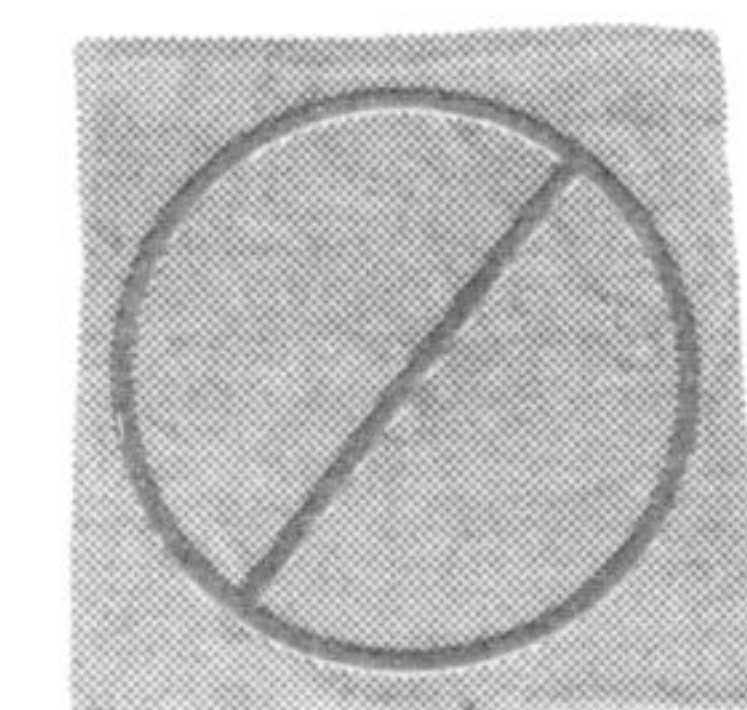
Glass bottles and jars
(food goes in GreenCart; bottles/jars go in Blue Box)



Clear plastic "clamshell" containers
(food goes in GreenCart; plastic containers go in garbage)



Plastic shopping bags, including ones that say "oxo-degradable"
(take back to the grocery store for recycling; "oxo-degradable" go in the garbage)



Clear plastic fruit & vegetable baggies
(food goes in GreenCart; plastic baggies go in garbage)
