Milton recognized for generosity

A national non-profit organization that works to help children escape poverty has recognized Milton for its generosity.

The Christian Children's Fund of Canada (CCFC) has awarded Milton a Lifetime Giving Award for donating more than \$403,000 over the past 20-plus years to poverty-stricken children in developing countries around the world.

Donations made by Miltonians in early 2009 pushed the town into the top 100 generous communities nationwide out of the approximately 4,600 towns and cities that donate to the organization.

"Milton has shown a generosity of

spirit that needs to be acknowledged, especially in light of current economic challenges," said Mark Lukowski, CEO of CCFC.

Currently, Milton residents sponsor a total of 105 children in Burkina Faso (Africa), Ghana, Ethiopia, Paraguay, Nicaragua, India, Sri Lanka and Tanzania.

Last year alone, they donated close to \$50,000.

More than 52,000 kids around the world are impacted by the work of CCFC.

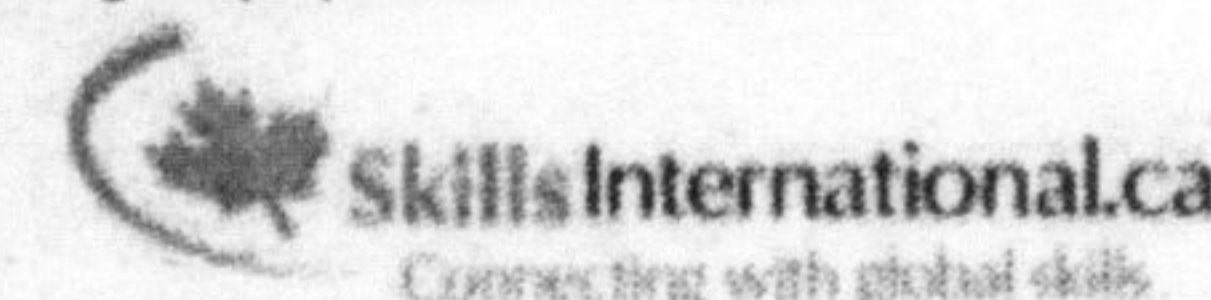

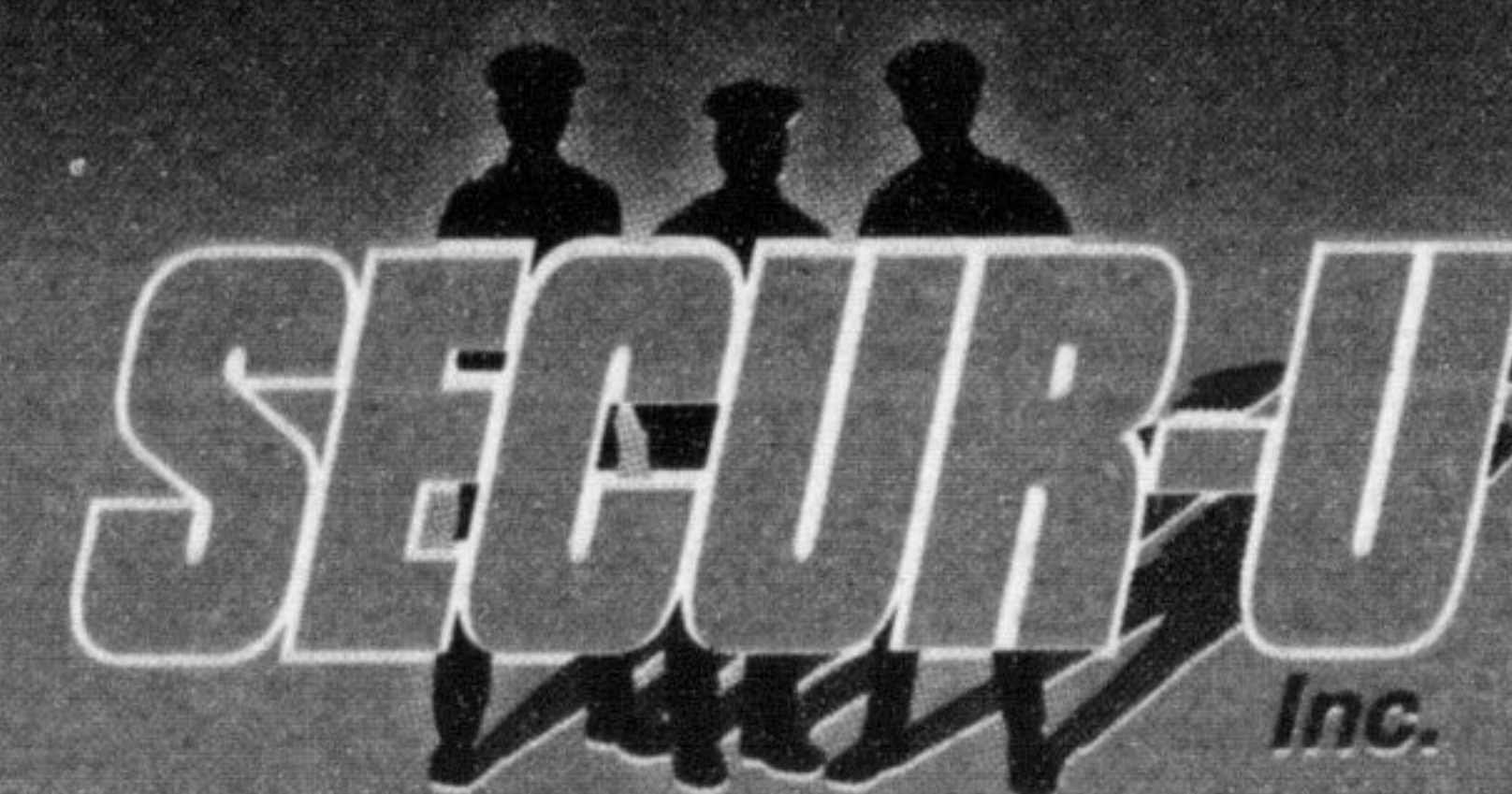
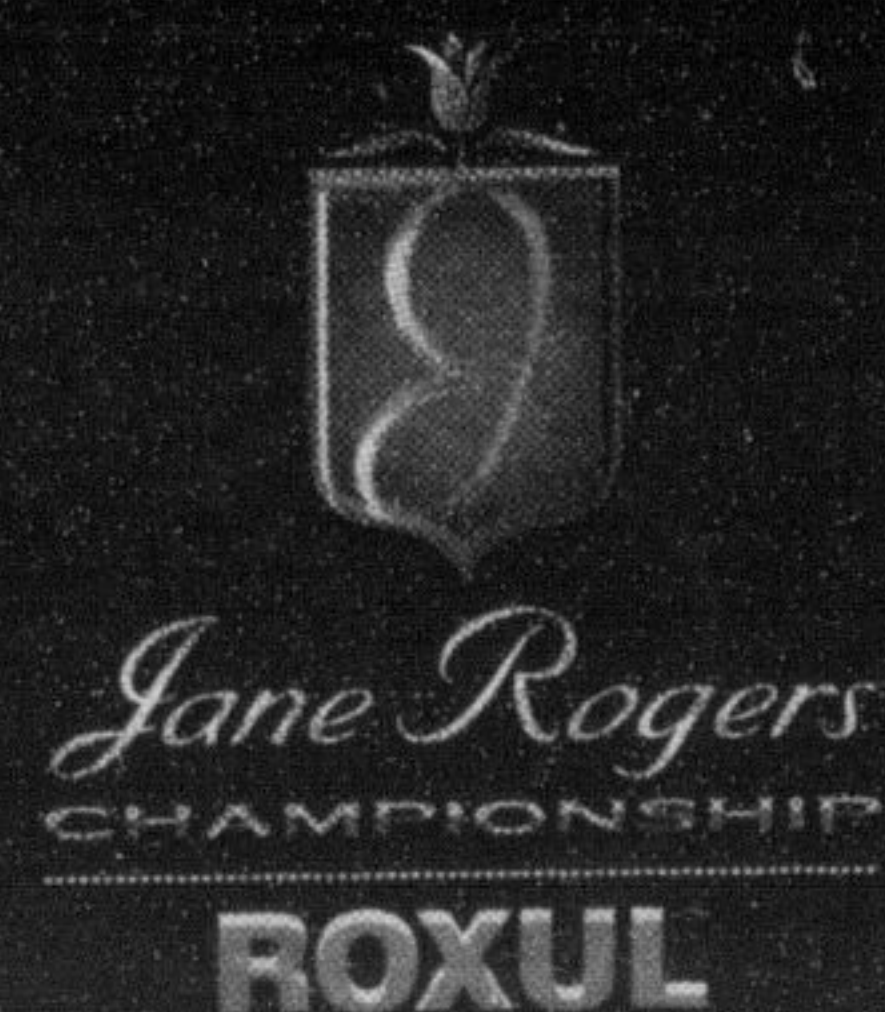
