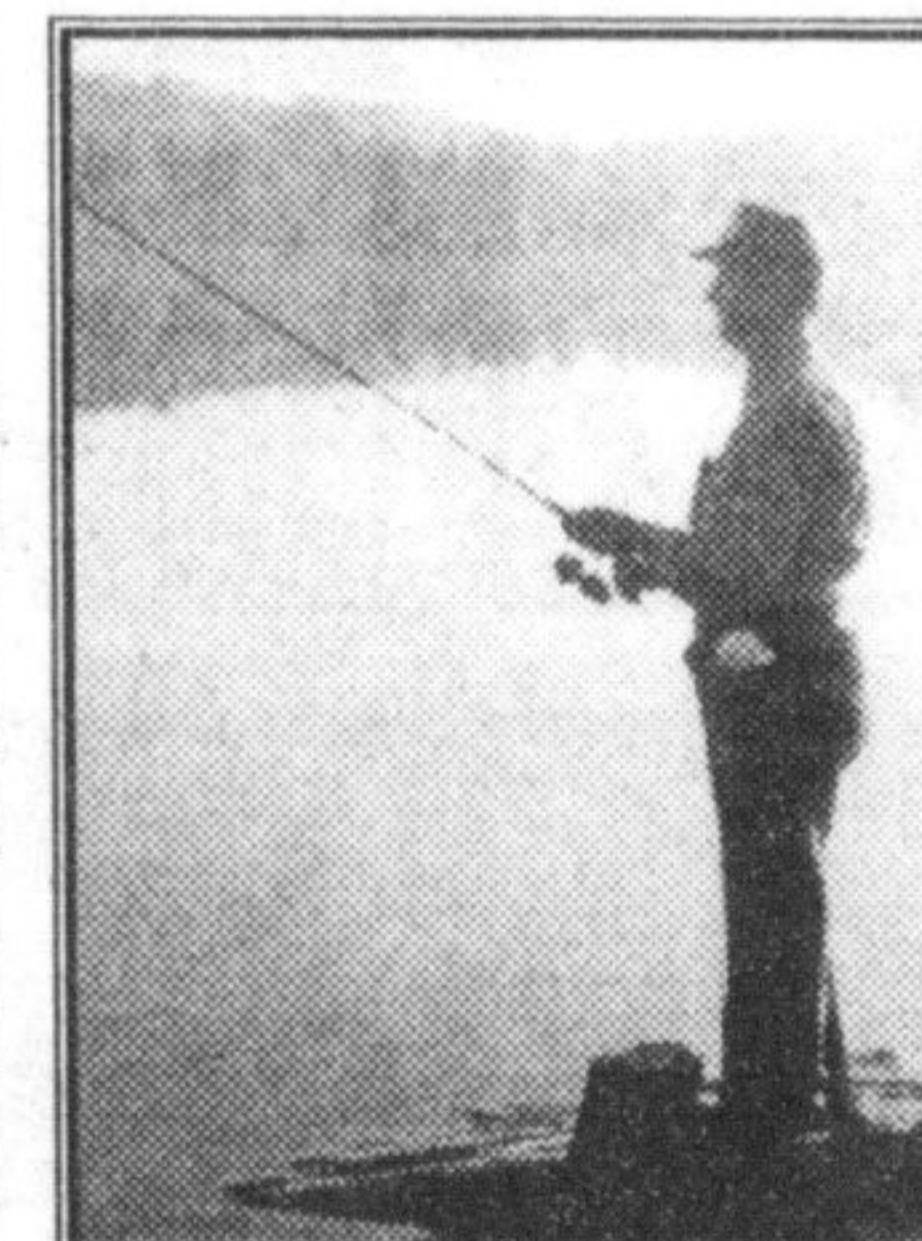
Noble-McKersie, Mary Patricia (Pat)
