

# Chudleigh takes over as Attorney General critic

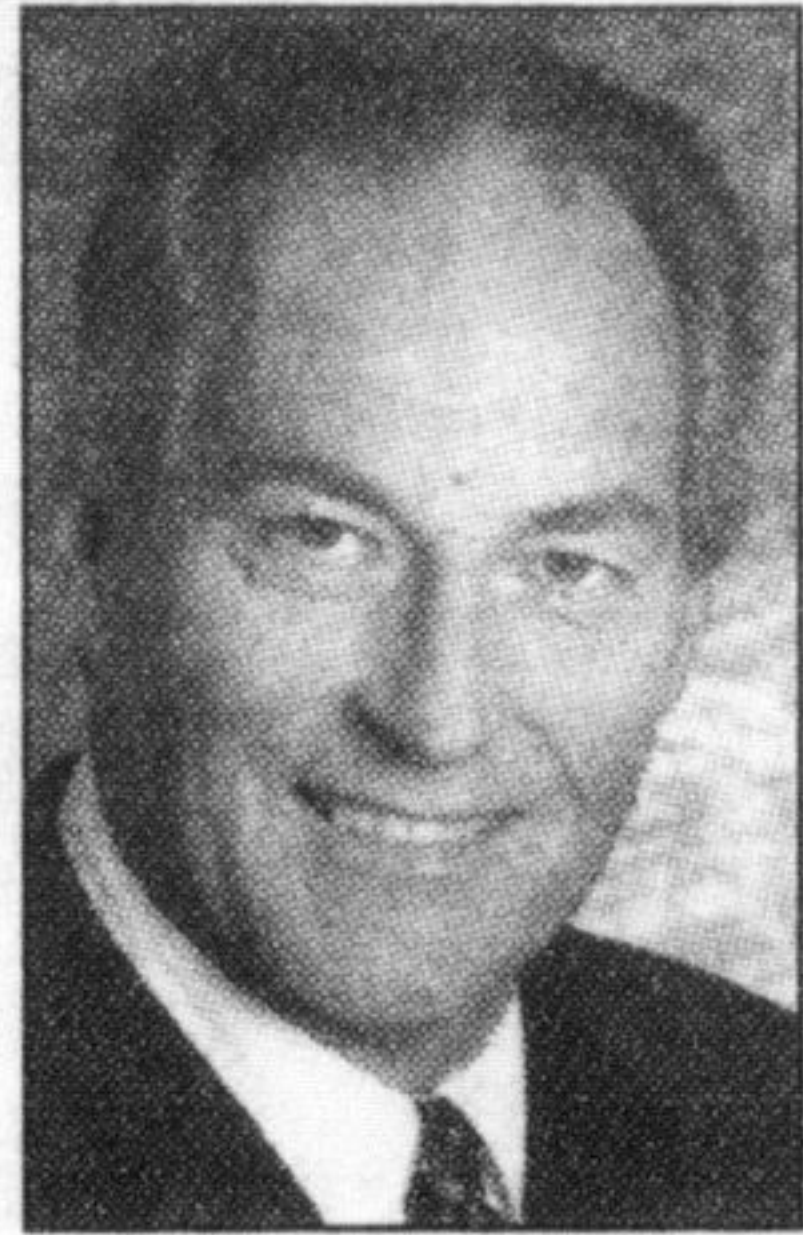
## Halton MPP's new post comes during cabinet shakeup

Halton MPP Ted Chudleigh has taken on the role of critic of the Attorney General in a shadow cabinet shakeup made yesterday by new Progressive Conservative leader Tim Hudak on Monday.

"My learning curve is going to be huge," admitted Chudleigh. "I've been reaching out all day to people who may be able to help me with that. So I'm looking forward to the opportunity."

Chudleigh had previously served as the Tory critic of Economic Development and International Trade, portfolios that garnered him occasional press in the current recession and fit with his business background. The unexpected role of critic for the Attorney General "came out of left field" as it wasn't one of the portfolios he had put forward to Hudak as possible shadow cabinet posts.

"And my initial reaction was surprise — you want me (to do) what?" joked Chudleigh, who doesn't have a legal background.

The government office of the Attorney General is generally held by those with a significant legal background due to the Minister's unique role of providing both policy advice to Cabinet and legal and constitutional advice.

The Attorney General is in charge of enforcing the rule of law in Ontario and overseeing the courts system. Liberal MP Chris Bentley, a former lawyer and part-time law professor, currently holds the post.

"I've been telling people all day I'm not handicapped with having a law degree, so hopefully (I can) bring some common sense to some of the things that are affecting the law," said Chudleigh.

The 14-year Halton MPP said that he planned to spend the next month reviewing

the file and plans to fill a vacant position in his Toronto office with someone with a background in the field.

Chudleigh also retained his position as deputy whip of the Tory caucus.

Thornhill MPP Peter Shurman has assumed Chudleigh's former duties of critic of economic development and trade.

The shakeup also affected the two other Tory MPPs in Halton. Wellington-Halton Hills representative Ted Arnott will act as

critic for both Aboriginal Affairs and Culture, moving out of his previous role of Tourism critic. Burlington MPP Joyce Savoline will take on the role of critic of the urban issues and housing portfolios of Municipal Affairs and Housing, with her former post as Education critic going to Elizabeth Witmer. As the former chair of Halton Region, the post should be a natural fit for Savoline.
