Waples steers way to Maple Leaf Trot win


Guides San Pail to victory; joins dad in champions' circle

With Miltonian Randy Waples at the reins and buoyed by a vocal cheering section, San Pail

pulled off an impressive upset in the 58th edition of the \$720,500 Maple Leaf Trot Saturday night at Mohawk.

Enjoying his 19th career win for trainer Rodney Hughes, the fiveyear-old gelding delivered a neck victory over reigning champion Arch Madness and 1-4 favourite Lucky Jim in 1:52.1.

San Pail had finished second to Lucky Jim their last time out, and with Saturday's triumph brought his rival's win streak to an end at 15.

"I couldn't be any happier," said Waples, moments after capturing his first Maple Leaf Trot — a race his Hall-of-Fame father Ron won five times. "I'm an emotional guy. This is sweet; really sweet. When I was a little kid I used to walk into Greenwood and see the big plaques on the wall, all the winners of the Canadian Pacing Derby and the Maple Leaf Trot, they were the two races to win when I was young. Now my name's on both of them."

San Pail prevailed on the strength of a brilliant drive from the local harness racing veteran, who admitted he may have over-raced him in the elimination — a race in which he was beaten by one-and-a-quarter lengths by Lucky Jim.

"I was so down on myself last week when I overraced him," Waples explained. "It worked out (tonight), and I can't say enough about Rod Hughes, the job that he's done with him. He's such a nice horse."
