



## Road, internet safety topics of MCPC forum

Safety on the computer and on the road are two topics of concern to many Miltonians.

This Wednesday, police officers will address both issues at the annual forum of the Milton Community Policing Committee (MCPC).

"This is our annual event to reach out to the public," said MCPC chair Tony Lambert.

The educational session will be held from 6 to 8:30 p.m. at W.I. Dick Public School, 351 Highside

Halton Regional Police Const. Noel Bowes will present on internet safety, while Sgt. Derek Davis will address road safety.

Insp. Al Frost said the forum provides a great opportunity for residents to have direct access to a police officer to ask questions or share concerns.

The segment on internet safety will be particularly important for parents, Frost said.

Bowes regularly goes into schools and talks with kids, so he has valuable insight about what kids are doing on-line that could

put them in danger, Frost said, and what parents should look out for.

"The internet is there and although there's good information, it's possible kids can venture into areas they shouldn't be," he said.

When it comes to road safety, Davis will discuss a number of traffic initiatives and enforcement campaigns police have put in place.

"He and his team are very industrious in trying to address a number of issues, many of which are trafficrelated," Frost said.

The forum will include a question-and-answer period for residents to have their say.

"Anything citizens are concerned about will be addressed at the forum — anything and everything," Lambert said.

The MCPC is a citizen-led volunteer organization that joins representatives from Halton Regional Police and the Town of Milton with residents in efforts to promote safety and address issues of concern.

There's no need to register ahead of time for the forum.

## Lots of speeding tickets issued in traffic enforcement initiative

Halton motorists need to slow down.

That's the message Halton Regional Police are offering in the wake of a high number of speeding violations discovered during their recent 'Safe Start' traffic initiative.

Held across the region last month as a means of promoting road safety - especially in school zones — the campaign resulted in 1,493 tickets being issued. Nearly two-thirds of those were for speeding, including 588 vehicles being stopped for going 16-to-29 km/h over the speed limit.

There were even two cases of drivers clocked at 50 km/h over the posted limit, police said.

Stop sign violations accounted for 277 of the tickets, while police issued 197 tickets for various offences under the Highway Traffic

The Safe Start program focused on the five S's - Speeding, Seatbelts, Stop Signs, School Zones and School Buses.
