## IceHawks powerless to stop skid

Christmas arrived early in Milton but the IceHawks were left with nothing but a big ol' lump of coal.

Kevin Christmas and the Kingston Voyageurs rolled over Milton 10-3 in Friday's Ontario Junior A Hockey League game. But instead of leaving the Hawks with tidings of joy, Christmas acted more like the grandmother who asks you if you've put on weight just as you're dishing out your second helping of dessert.

The Kingston forward's power-play goal midway through the second period served to highlight a major reason why the Hawks now find themselves in the midst of an eight-game losing streak. During that span, the Hawks have failed to score on 53 consecutive power-play opportunities.

And after Aurora scored two shorthanded goals in Sunday's 5-1 win, the IceHawks may want to consider taking a page from the football playbook and start declining their opponents' penalties.

How far has Milton's power-less play sunk? The Hawks have had the equivalent of four full periods of power-play time — 85 minutes and 53 seconds — without producing a goal. That includes more than six minutes with a

two-man advantage. Their last goal on the power play was almost a full month ago, in their last win on Oct. 9 against Bramalea.

Milton's other 'special' team hasn't fared a lot better. The league-worst penalty-killing unit has surrendered 17 goals over the same span — but at least it has produced a goal. The Hawks' had allowed a power-play goal in 14 straight games (32 goals in total) until shutting down Aurora on all 11 of its opportunities on Sunday.

Aurora's dismal showing dropped it to second worst in the league, having only taken advantage of 13.5 per cent of its chances this season. That's still well above Milton's rate of 7.8 per cent.

As long as the IceHawks' special teams keeps spotting the opposition a couple of goals each game, their third win may be on their wish list for a long time.

Notes: Evan Matheson, Sam Gilbert and Chris Micallef scored Milton's goals against Kingston....The defending league champs outshot the IceHawks 68-18....Justin Periera had Milton's lone goal against Aurora....Milton hosts Buffalo Friday at 7:30 p.m. and Aurora Sunday at 3:30 p.m. Both games are at Memorial Arena.

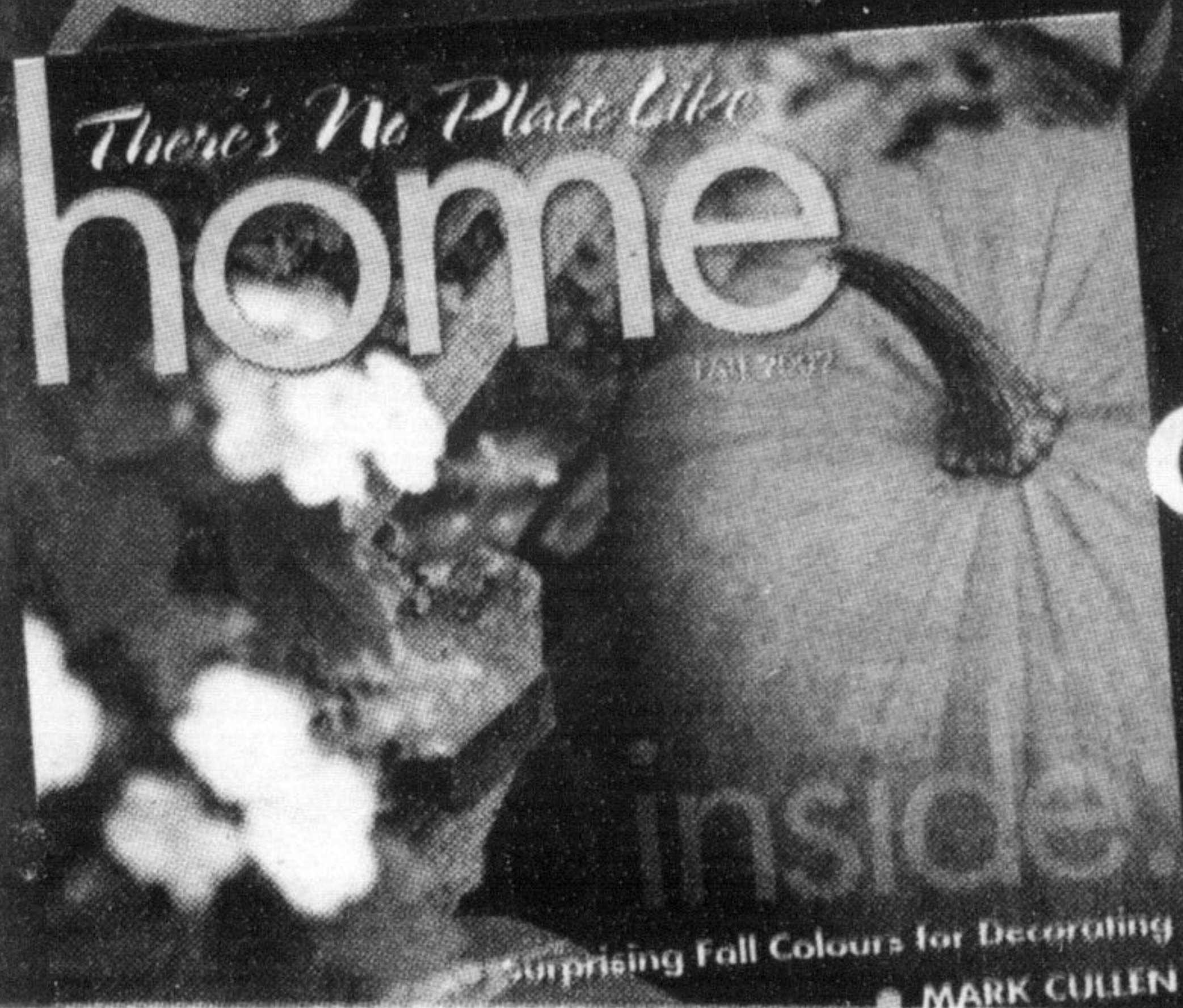
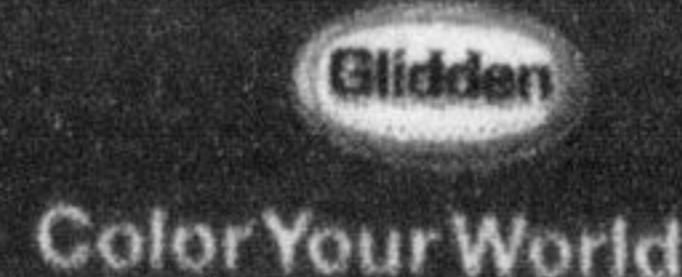
