

# AE novices eclipsed in epic semifinal showdown

## Winterhawks finally beaten in sixth overtime round

Hard to say what held a stronger grasp on Milton's AE novices in Flamborough Sunday morning, agony or exhaustion.

Both were certainly in abundance. Running on empty after a whopping six rounds of overtime, the Winterhawks were finally vanquished 3-2 by the Georgetown Raiders in the semifinals of the Energizer Fall Face-Off Tournament.

The teams were down to just one skater a side and no goalies — with captain Justin Lozer out for Milton — when Georgetown wired a well-placed shot into the unguarded cage to close out the epic encounter.



Josh Ben had made a number of dynamite saves through the seemingly-endless game, while Gavin Snow and Tyler Delfino scored in regulation.

While Lozer wasn't able to find the back of the net in the semifinals, he had no trouble doing so through round-robin play. He led the Winterhawks with five goals, including two shorthanded deposits in a 5-3 decision over the tournament hosts — highlighting a five-goals-in-five-minute surge in the third period.

Snow, Randall Samms and Alexander Giglio rounded out the scoring in the third-

round comeback victory, which followed a 4-0 whitewash of Grimsby.

Ben stood tall between the pipes and his teammates managed to kill a 5-on-3 power-play to preserve the shutout. Lozer, Snow, Adrian Channell and Josh Van Zuylen were the marksmen.

Lozer enjoyed an explosive start to the weekend, recording two goals and a pair of

assists in a 6-1 rout of Waterloo. Also lighting the lamp were Channell, Ben Marshall and Connor Quann.

Kevin Lyons, Noah Pittman, Stephen Stelmach and Matthew Anderson comprised a blueline unit that provided plenty of support for their rock-solid netminder, while coming away with game MVP honours were Lozer, Ben, Delfino and Luke D'Addario.

## Solid effort by AE minor peewees

Stepping things up after a sluggish start at last weekend's Flamborough Energizer Fall Face-Off Tournament, Milton's AE minor peewees gutted out two hard-fought wins to close out round-robin play at 2-1.

Unfortunately that wasn't quite enough for advancement to the semifinals, as Milton got bumped out via a points-per-game tiebreaking format.

Regrouping from a 4-0 opening-round loss to Waterloo, the Winterhawks came out flying and toppled the North London Nationals 5-2. Defenceman Jeffrey Gorman led with a three-point game while Josh McMillian was solid in net. Cameron Gulley kicked off the scoring, with other goals

recorded by Tyler Webb and Christian Vandervoet.

Milton then closed out preliminary play with a 2-1 squeaker over the Aurora Tigers.

Daniel Bensusan potted the game winner midway through the second period — with Gorman setting him up — while the Gulley, Webb, Carter Taylor line delivered a fantastic playmaking effort early on for the initial tally.

An impressive performance by the entire blueline unit and a strong showing from McMillan factored heavily into the win.

Milton kept its winning ways going with a 2-0 victory over Brampton Wednesday. McMillan earned the shutout and Nathan Carter and Parker Jacobs did the scoring.

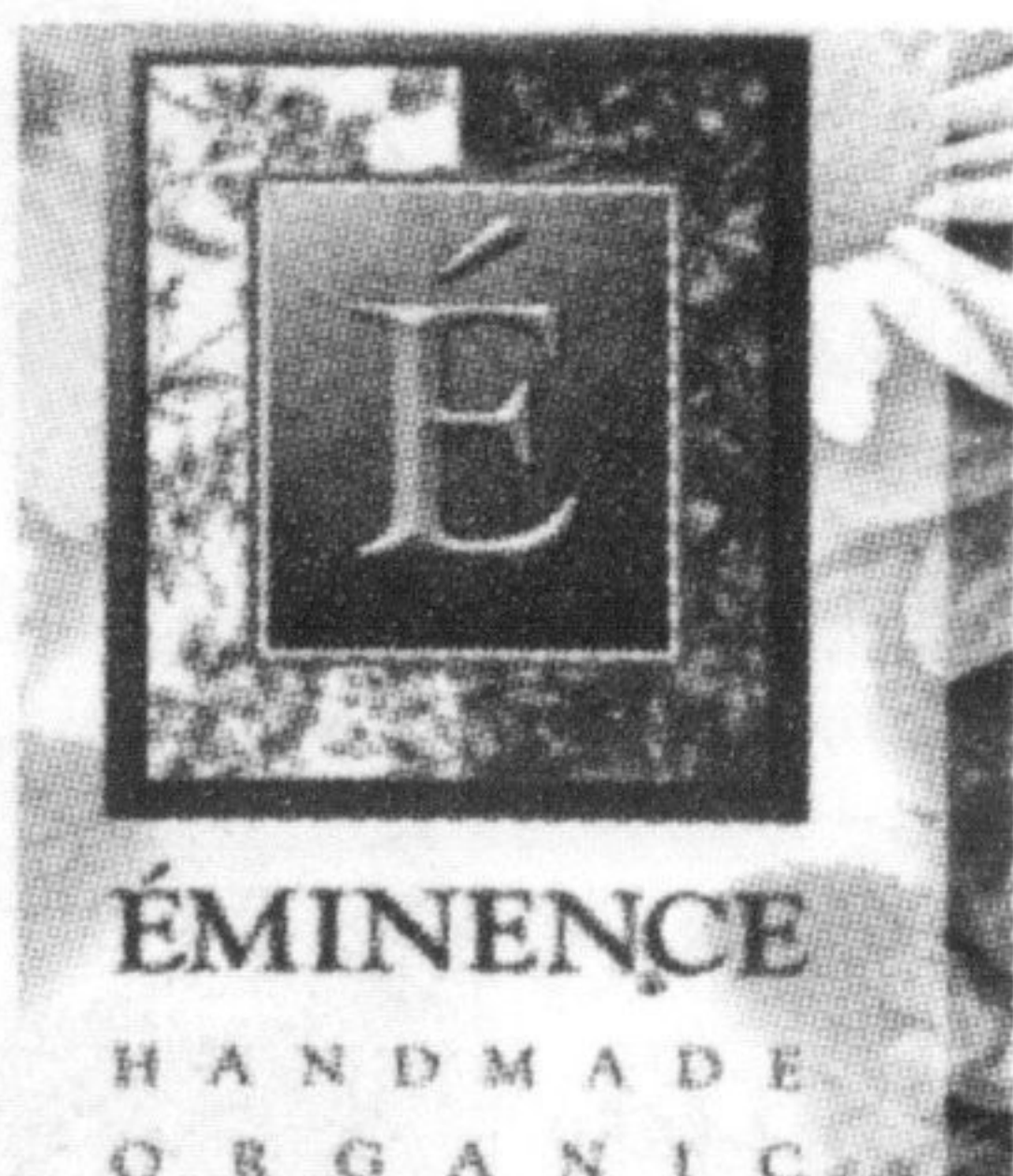

### Notice of Public Meeting Regarding General Amendments to the Town of Milton Comprehensive Zoning By-law 144-2003, as Amended

These are Town-initiated amendments that affect all lands within the Town of Milton.

Members of the public are invited to attend and provide input at a public meeting on proposed amendments to the Town's Comprehensive Zoning By-law 144-2003, as amended.

1. A general amendment relating to uses, regulations, and provisions of the Comprehensive Zoning By-law 144-2003, as amended, including:

- To add a new definition and provisions for Bicycle Parking requirements;
- To amend wording related to the definitions of "Driveway, Residential", "Warehouse/Distribution Centre", and the requirements of "Restaurant Patios" and parking requirements for Recreation & Athletic Facilities and Public Parks.

As this initiative is Town Wide, there is no property description or map provided with this Notice.
